Decathlon(6/25-26): (The scoring here is very confusing, so please bear with us as we try to explain: the automatic timing device broke for one of the heats of the 100. Since hand-timing was available for the

auto-timed heat, the event was scored with hand-timing. The decision was then made to continue to auto-time the rest of the meet, producing a hybrid. But when the auto-timer malfunctioned in one of the heats of the 1500, that event was also hand-timed. Which yielded "official" scores combining the two timing methods.

T&FN will ignore these hybrid scores, instead going with the consistent hand times which were available for all competitors. Fully-automatic scores are available only for Jenner and George.

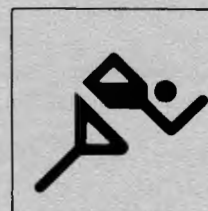
