## RONO RUNS WILD—13:08.4m

In an amazing breakthrough reminiscent of that made by teammate Samson Kimobwa last year at 10,000 meters, Washington State soph Henry Rono stunned the track world with a world record 13:08.4 in dual meet competition (Berkeley, April 8).

Kimobwa and Josh Kimeto helped Rono with the pace for the first 4 laps, then dropped back as Rono forged on alone. Rough splits for the first 2 miles were 4:15 and 8:28.

"After the 2M I knew I had the record," said Rono.

The Kenyan star, who also leads the world at 10,000 meters (27:48.6 in New Zealand in January), made a quantum leap in chopping 4.5 seconds off Dick Quax's 9-month-old record. He ripped 13.7 seconds off his PR and moved all the way from 37th on the all-time list to the No. 1 spot.

Coach John Chaplin says to look for Rono to set a collegiate steeple record in Eugene this weekend: that's sub-8:20 talk.

She won't compete domestically, saving it for the tougher competition abroad...
