AAU CHAMPIONSHIPS

Westwood, June 8-10—After having to share the NCAA limelight with Henry Rono and Greg Foster, Clancy Edwards took over at the AAU Championships. UCLA's track was kind to the Southern Cal sprinter as he displayed his typical late-rush to score an impressive 100/200 double. That made him the first since Hal Davis in 1943 to score an NCAA/AAU quadruple.

The meet's record-setting was left to the women, as Jodi Anderson (LJ) and Brenda Morehead (200) notched new American standards (although Morehead ended up losing the final).

- Two late-arriving performances add even more to an already-super season. First, Poland's Grazyna Rabsztyn clicked over the 100-meter hurdles in a speedy 12.48 (Warsaw, June 10), trimming the world mark of 12.59 by a healthy .11. That effort won the '72 Olympic title for East Germany's Annelie Ehrhardt.

- The next day (6/11) in Vienna, who else but Henry Rono went to work again and axed the world 10,000 record to 27:22.5, slashing the 27:30.5 run last year by Kenya and Washington State countryman Samson Kimobwa. Rono's last lap was reported to be 57.0—which means there's a lot left there, folks.
