YASHCHENKO AGAIN

It didn't take long for the European season to get rolling. Indeed, as we closed the last issue of *TN*, we brought you the flash of world records by Henry (yawn) Rono and Grazyna Rabsztyn. We've got more details on those for you this time.

And in the interim, another major world record has toppled, as young Soviet Vladimir Yashchenko has high jumped 2.34 (7-8), adding a centimeter to the mark he set last summer. That's still an increment below his indoor best of 7-8½ of course.

Bay Area fans will be excited to learn that Yashchenko is on the preliminary visa list received from the Soviets, indicating that he will probably be in Berkeley for the US-USSR affair. He's worth the price of admission himself.

Some European papers carried a rumor that Rono's 27:22.5 in the 10,000 (finished off by a 13:34.3 [!] 5000) might not be ratified by the IAAF because of technical irregularities. As far as we can determine, the "irregularities" center around Jos Hermens not finishing the race after setting a fast pace, therefore acting as a rabbit.

This charge has no basis, as the IAAF has removed the rabbit-rule from its files.

Informed sources tell us that Vienna 10,000 was Rono's last race at the distance for the year. He'll be content to claim No. 1 world ranking off his record to date. And reportedly he will only run in a couple more meets period, in the 5000 and steeple. We'll see how that story stands up when the promoters come running with their fistsfull of crowns, marks, francs, etc.

His rest-period between the intervals was 0. That's 3000 meters in 7:32.1, chopping 3.1 from Brendan Foster's old WR. He murdered a good field: 2. Nyambui 7:40.3; 3. Rose 7:40.4; 4. Dixon 7:41.1.
