7 MORE WORLD RECORDS

As we saw in the last edition of *TN*, the Europeans were beginning to break out of their pre-Prague slumber, soaring to new heights in their drive for European titles. World records had just come from Sara Simeoni, Karl-Hans Riehm and Wolfgang Schmidt.

There were records at Prague, too, as you shall see, but in a frantic period in mid-August, another 7 world records (and 2 in unrecognized events) were set, by Evelin Jahl, the USSR 4 x 800 (men), Vilma Bardauskiene (twice), Marita Koch (again), the East German women's 4 x 100 and by Krystyna Kacperczyk and Tatyana Selenzova in the 400H.

★ ★ ★ Dresden, E. G., Aug. 12—Evelin Jahl gave East Germany both discus world marks, following Wolfgang Schmidt's 233-5 three days later with a 232-0 of her own. That added 9" to Faina Veleva's '76 record. Jahl had 2 other throws land beyond 220 feet and her 4 fair heaves averaged 222-4. The meet also produced superb sprinting from Marlies Gohr and the women's 4 x 100 team.

★ ★ ★ Podolsk, USSR, Aug. 12—Four Soviet 2-lappers got together and a world 4 x 800 mark of 7:08.1 was the result. That clipped West Germany's '66 record by a half-second. Vladimir Podolyakov, Nikolay Kirov, Vladimir Malozemlin and Anatoliy Reshetnyak averaged 1:47.025 for each leg.

BARDAUSKIENE 23-2¼

★ ★ ★ Kishinyov, USSR, Aug. 18—Vilma Bardauskiene, who could manage a mere 21-¾ vs. the U. S. some 5 weeks earlier, exploded to become the first woman to long jump beyond both the 7-meter (22-11½) and 23-foot barriers when she spanned 23-2¼. And she was hot from the start, bounding the record on her first jump, matching it again later in her series (exact order not available at presstime) and also hitting 23-2 for the No. 3 effort in history.

Another jumping revelation was 19-year-old Aleksandr Lisichonok, who triple jumped a European Junior record 55-9¼—the best-ever non-altitude jump by a Junior and a rather significant lengthening of his previous best of 52-10¾, reached in the USSR title meet.

KACPERCZYK 55.44

★★★ Berlin, W. G., Aug. 18—Poland's Krystyna Kacperczyk regained the world 400 hurdles record and Doug Brown reclaimed the American steeplechase record at the ISTAF meet. Kacperczyk's 55.44 cut Karin Rossley's global mark by 0.19; Kacperczyk was the first official holder of the women's 400 hurdles record with her 56.51 back in '74.

Brown, former U.S. recordman at 8:23.2 (also in '74) became the first American to duck under 8:20 with his 8:19.3, which clipped 2.3 seconds off Henry Marsh's '77 best. Brown finished 2nd to Bronislaw Malinowski, who cruised a fine 8:11.6, history's No. 7 effort ever.

One other world best fell on the '36 Olympic track as Ulrike Bruns cut 0.7 from her 1000 meter mark with 2:32.0. She set the old mark back in May.

★★★ Podolsk, USSR, Aug. 19-20—the final Soviet tune-up meet before Prague saw fireworks produced by two Tatyanas—namely, a world record 55.31 in the 400 hurdles by Selenzova and a world best 2:30.6 for 1000 meters by Providokhina. Selenzova's first-day mark let Krystyna Kacperczyk's 55.44 from the ISTAF meet survive only 24 hours. Providokhina cut 1.4 off Ulrike Bruns' 2-day old mark.

G., Aug. 19—East Germany's seemingly bottomless reservoir of women's sprint talent reached a boil as Marita Koch got her 2nd 400 world record of the year—this one 49.02—and the DDR 4 x 100 team hooked up for a 42.27 record. Koch sliced 0.17 from her mark of earlier this summer, while the relayers reduced a 42.50 clocking by a '76 DDR team.
