Abilene, May 5—Texas prep Mike Carter (Jefferson, Dallas) came up with 4 amazing performances at the Abilene Christian open:

Only one other prep has thrown the HS disc as far this season. The 177-2 is only 2" off the prep record. The 12 SP mark added more than 2 feet to his own HSR (he was throwing this at the same time as the big disc, hence the incomplete series). With the big shot, he broke his own HSR of 61-4½ (1978) on his second throw, then added another 3 feet in the 5th round.
