This represents the "final" U.S. women's list for the 1983 season in all sprint events except for the marathon, which still has much action remaining and will be included 2 issues from now.

The lists include at least 35 U.S. citizens except in non-national championship events (e.g., mile) and relays (e.g., 4 x 200), and at least 10 performances. Where more than 10 performances are listed, it is done to list all the performances making the all-time U.S. top 25. The end of a performance section is denoted by an underscore. Resident foreigners are listed after the main body of U.S. performers, and any foreign performances qualifying for a combined (U.S. and residents) top 10 are also underscored within the resident foreigners section. In field events, each mark within a series is considered a performance. The reporting standard for the year is listed at the end of the main body of the U.S. lists (and just ahead of the resident foreigners).

Records are listed at the head of each event. Record symbols: W=World; A=American; C=Collegiate; WJ=World Junior; AJ=American Junior.

Conversion factors are listed after the records of each affected event. Wind-aided and hand-timed lists are given after the main body and include marks only when intrinsically superior to the best legal mark using the accepted factors of 0.24 for straight events and 200s and 0.14 for one-lap events. For events longer than 400 meters, hand-timed marks are not converted but are given an inferior position to auto-timed marks when both have the same tenth decimal (e.g., 2:05.39 is listed ahead of 2:05.3).

Symbols: (A)=mark made at an altitude above 1000 meters; i=indoor mark; ' after an athlete's name=resident foreigner; l=secondary mark within a field-event series; &=mark made on Boston College's oversized 434-meter track in Chestnut Hill; collegiate classes=****fresh; **sophomore; *junior; -senior; ?=class unknown.
