Nebraska Still Perfect

Competing in the unscored Kansas State Invitational last weekend, Gary Pepin's Huskers had no problems holding onto their unanimous No. 1 ranking in the *USTCA/T&FN Coaches Dual Meet Poll*.

Illinois rebounded into No. 2 and narrowed the gap a bit after winning a quad meet the previous weekend. Tennessee dropped from No. 2 to No. 4.

The biggest improvement came from Minnesota, coming from nowhere to rate No. 6. Another latecomer to the poll, NCAA fave LSU finally entered the fray at No. 21. The Tigers may be underrated, but they're also a non-factor in the distances, which costs them big points in the power ratings.

Notably absent from the poll are Texas and Florida, neither of which have turned in team depth charts to the keeper of the power ratings, Dave Nielsen of Idaho State.

Chinese Test Negative

In the wake of the Chinese women's record-breaking spree late last year, the IAAF sent in one of its "flying squads" to make a surprise test on the Ma Junren's runners.

Headed by a Norwegian official, the 3-person IAAF team took urine samples from 13 of Ma's runners at his training camp.

"It is correct for us to be tested," said Ma. "As long as athletes are members of Ma's Army, they will be cooperative."

Staffan Sahlstrom, whose Swedish-based International Doping Tests & Management, organizes the IAAF's testing, told *Keeping Track* that this was the first unannounced test conducted in China.

At about the same time, the IAAF also sent a team to Eugene to test some American athletes.

Sahlstrom says that IAAF testers attempt to obtain samples within an hour of first contact with the athlete, unlike the USATF procedure, which gives up to 48 hours notice. "Forty-eight hours is not effective," Sahlstrom told *KT*.

The IAAF testing is aimed at steroid/testosterone abuse, and does not look for the types of substances typically found in over-the-counter cold remedies.

Nor can it catch those using Chorionic Gonadotrophin, Corticotrophin, HGH or EPO, all of which are strong doping agents.

In mid-February the IAAF announced that all the Chinese random tests—including big names Wang Junxia and Qu Yunxia—had come back negative.

Good & Bad In NYC

From its construction in 1910 until the mid-1980s, the Fort Washington Armory in New York City hosted meets and provided

training facilities literally for generations of high school and college athletes.

Last December the armory came full circle, reopening with its fully refurbished arena, state-of-the art track and stands for 5000 people. Three years of nonstop work had made Dr. Norb Sander's dream come true.

Response to the facility has been fantastic, with 50-odd meets this winter, and rejuvenation of the sport in one of the nation's most important cities.

That's the good news. The bad: the state's Public High Schools Athletic Association has voted to eliminate the Big Apple's public and Catholic high schools from state title events beginning this fall.

The late-January decision could affect more than 30,000 athletes in 157 schools. Track athletes from New York City schools have long dominated state competition.

That very dominance was a prime reason given for the exclusion. Said PHSAA president Karen Lopez, "We would like to crown our [association] champions first."

City school officials have threatened legal action. The PHSAA later made a counter suggestion of holding a state event for all schools after PHSAA schools have what would amount to a league meet.
