## A Tie For No. 1

The selectors smiled upon Doug Brown's Tennessee squad, previously ranked only No. 19. This week, after they showed off their team depth with a 2nd at the SEC champs, the Vols were promoted to a tie for No. 1 with Nebraska in the USTCA/T&FN Coaches Dual Meet Poll.

Another big improver was Texas, No. 12 two weeks ago. Now the Longhorns are at No. 3. Arkansas, which topped Tennessee at SECs and earlier beat Nebraska head-to-head, remained at No. 10.

## Milers Return From Injury

Two of the top thoroughbreds in the Georgetown-based Enclave had to miss the indoor season because of injury. But both Steve Holman and Bill Burke are now back training, with big plans for the outdoor campaign.

For Holman, who was troubled by injury last year, it was more of the same. "It was a fracture or a stress syndrome in my left tibia, the same area where I had a stress fracture last spring," explains the 3:34.95 performer.

"I only missed a month of training."

Burke, last year's USATF 1500 champ, was hit by his stress fracture (right foot) in early January. "It obliterated my indoor season," he says. "I've never been injured like this before, so I didn't know what to expect.

"I started running again recently. I missed six weeks of training and had to do the pool running thing. I'm getting back into form now; I'm primarily concerned with getting into shape. I'll know within the next week or so where I really am."

Both runners, coached by Georgetown's

Frank Gagliano and Matt Centrowitz, feel they'll have the opportunity for a full outdoor campaign.

Says Holman, "I'll open with a 5000 at the NC State Relays. I've always been a strength-oriented runner. I never got a chance to do [the 5000] in college. I can do a little more experimentation now.

"I ran the 5000 at Penn last year, but it was sub-par [14:06.86]. I was hurt then."

Also hoping to run the 800 more, Holman wants to improve on his PR of 1:47.54: "My feeling is I'm the type of miler I am because I have range above and below it."

Burke's aim is simple. "My goal is to improve," he says. "It's not an Olympic or World Championship year. So I'd just like to improve on my 3:35.74 and race more consistently on an international level."

The two will soon be joined in the 1500 by training partner Rich Kenah, mainly an 800 man to this point (1:45.98). Says Kenah, "I will run the 1500 at the '96 Oly Trials. By then, I think I will be able to run 3:35 or 3:36, and that will make the team." Kenah will begin his conversion this spring.

## Money For Foreigners Only

Earlier this winter long-dash star Michael Johnson told *USA Today* that he would be skipping the USATF Indoor Championships because the national governing body was paying foreign stars to attend but not Americans.

After initially tap-dancing around the subject, USATF released a statement explaining that foreigners indeed do get money not available to Americans:

"Over a decade ago, at the annual convention, a resolution to eliminate foreign athletes from the indoor nationals was introduced. The motion was defeated by USATF's membership—including athletes—who felt that foreign stars are needed in events that lack a strong U.S. presence.

"Payment for foreign athletes who are invited to the indoor championships comes from private, outside sources. These funds are made available through USATF solely to attract top international stars. The money is earmarked strictly for the foreigners, and would not be available to USATF for any other purpose. The foreign athletes are invited to maintain the highest level of competition."

West Lafayette, Indiana, February 25-26—Michigan's women distance runners, like their male counterparts, propelled the Wolverines to the team title. At the mile/3000/5000, Molly McClimon placed 2-1-1, while Courtney Babcock took 1-2-2.
