Track Comes To Atlanta

Atlanta, March 4-5—That the proud city of Atlanta will support football and baseball is a given. Whether or not it would support track & field was a question that remained unanswered on the dawn of the USATF Indoor Championships. It was/is by no means an unimportant question, as the national governing body has forsaken its longtime home in Madison Square Garden and signed a 10-year deal to reside in Georgia.

Hurdle one was cleared with flying colors, as the largest crowd in nationals history, 19,080, showed up on Saturday and saw just how well American athletes can perform on a state-of-the-art indoor oval.

The circuit in question, all \$600,000 of it, was a bright blue, banked 6-lane 200m Mondo creation virtually identical to the one used in Toronto last year for the World Indoor Championships.

And it was fast, particularly for the long sprinters, most of whom could never do anything but hold on and pray on the Garden's tight 11-lap setup.

Gwen Torrence, clearly the outstanding performer of the meet, found the track a little tough to get used to in the initial going, saying, "The track is slippery. I kept trying to flap my way," after the 200 heats. Nonetheless, it was a heat which produced an AR 22.84.

She was even better the next day, running in a nuclear pink bodysuit that provided a psychedelic color combination with the blue track. First she annihilated the 60 field with a 7.10 clocking, then stomped her 200 competition with another AR, this one 22.74.

Jackie Joyner-Kersey came close to matching Torrence's achievement. The AR part was the easy one, relatively speaking, as she stretched out to 23-4³/₄ (7.13) in the long jump. But in trying to become a double victor, JJK whacked the fourth hurdle while in the lead and ended up splattered all over the track. "I've never really fallen hard like that," she said.

Warming up for this weekend's important NCAA Championships, Chris Nelloms also took advantage of the swift oval. The Ohio State senior zipped to a 20.57 for one lap, taking 0.02 off Michael Johnson's Collegiate Record.

If there was a down side to the whole affair, it was the thinness of some of the

fields. Not just the big names (some of whom pointedly stayed away because they didn't like the financial arrangements), but also some of the second-level people who keep the meet solid.

One would like to hope that now that the speed value of the venue has been confirmed that more athletes will want to compete here in the future. We'd particularly like to see collegiate coaches avail themselves of such a fine competitive opportunity the final week before the NCs, instead of competing in all those meaningless "last chance" affairs that now blight the early-March landscape.

One somber note was sounded by Steve Hummer in the *Atlanta Journal-Constitution*, in noting the absence of local Olympic honcho Billy Payne, who instead of being at the meet was at Georgia's spring football game.

Said Hummer, "Let that stand as a symbol of priorities in these parts. All that running and jumping business is fine, but if it doesn't yield some clues on how to beat Florida, then what's the use?"
