## Trouble In The Walk World

Another Italian official is in trouble, reports Neil Wilson in London's *Daily Mail*. Wilson has confirmed rumors which began to circulate on the track grapevine after last month's special Walking Commission meeting at IAAF headquarters in Monaco.

Wilson says the judge, Nicola Maggio, wrongly DQed Mexican Daniel Garcia near the end of the Stuttgart 20, giving silver to Italian Giovanni de Benedictis. Reportedly, the commission charged Maggio with "total disregard" for accepted procedures and "behaving detrimentally" to the best interest of the sport. Letters recommending his suspension have apparently been filed.

Wilson also recalled the Evangelisti scandal from the 1987 World Championships, where Italian officials conspired to fix the long jump results.

Concluded Wilson, "A second scandal involving Italians could have serious implications for [IAAF President Primo] Nebiolo when he seeks reelection next year."

A week later, British walk judge Peter Marlow went public on the subject and said he would withdraw from judging at the European Champs this summer unless the whole situation is properly investigated.

"What started as a simple breach of regulations is turning into a major incident," said Marlow. "If it is a whitewash I would not judge."

Marlow also said he had been summoned to a meeting with Nebiolo, and it hadn't been a pleasant experience. "I felt as though I was a person on death row," he said. "They accused me of lying."

## Modesto Dead, Reborn

Given up for dead in early March when its big backer decided to cease financial support, the Modesto Invitational is back on track for 1994, albeit in a reduced fashion. After S&W pulled out, it was originally announced that the historic affair would come to an end.

"We're going ahead with the meet," says Tom Moore, the meet's director for 50 of its 52 years. "We have no major sponsor but we have a committee formed and we're in the process of trying to raise funds."

Modesto proved to have nationwide appeal, and Moore was impressed at the cries

of woe he heard.

"There was a great expression of disappointment," he says of coaches and athletes who contacted him. "They were all disappointed that a meet of this stature was going to go by the wayside. That was the main factor that got us to find a way to continue this meet."

The meet, May 14, will be staged on a tight budget and won't pay appearance fees, which certainly won't sit well with today's big-name athletes (and their agents).
