Exciting Vault Concept

Bob Fraley is an idea kind of guy, especially when it come to promoting track & field.

His latest creation is the North American Pole Vault Association. Explains Fresno State's field-event coach, "At the Reno Vault Summit in January many of the elite jumpers said to me, 'We need competition.'"

Fraley didn't have to wear his thinking cap very long before the concept of the Vault Association was born. Following the lines of a number of pro sports—golf, rodeo, even bass fishing—the vaulters anted up \$300 dues for membership.

The current roster stands at 11: Simon Arkell, John Besmer, Tim Bright, Brent Burns, Jim Drath, Doug Fraley, Ron Johnson, Scott Krupilski, Derek Oliver, Dean Starkey, Garth Willard.

"The first thing the athletes had to understand was that they are investing in themselves," Fraley says. The group will sponsor vaults in five major West Coast meets this spring—Fresno, Mt. SAC, Modesto, adidas/Portland and Jenner.

Vaulters will accumulate points under Grand Prix-style scoring, with prize money distributed at the end of the series.

As well, Fraley has secured individual and corporate contributions for the Association, and those sponsors will be recognized at various meets.

"We want to acknowledge those who have contributed behind the scenes, too," says Fraley. "But it's most important for the athletes to understand that their membership involves a commitment by them of time and effort.

"That might mean doing clinics, making appearances, signing autographs. But those things connect fans—especially kids—to the athletes."

event will be a street vault held in New Orleans' French Quarter in August.

For this season, though, the Association's circuit is termed the "Western Division." Fraley notes, "There just wasn't enough time to set up more. But if things go well this year, we'd like to try for a more national circuit next year."

Roadies Working Together

The road running community has embarked on a unified campaign to find ways to promote itself better, in a marked departure from a past that saw little in the way of cooperation among races, shoe companies and athletes.

The move to come together sparked Road Summit '94, held in late February in Washington, D.C. Delegates—88 of them—came from every corner of the road running map to discuss a number of issues.

Among their concerns was the aging of the running population. Basil Honickman of the Road Running Information Center said that while participation is still growing overall, there has been little growth seen in the 18-25 age group.

Attendees looked for ways to boost the creation of heroes in a sport which of late has lacked in names that generate great interest in the general public. "Heroes have to create themselves," argued Amby Burfoot, editor of *Runner's World*.

There was vigorous debate on whether or not a need exists to publicizing running and racing to a broader audience. Said Marty Liquori, "We know who runs. It's a white yuppie sport. We're not out to save the world. We're here to save our sport."

The structure of the sport also got a hard look, with an eye toward creating a strong national organization devoted solely to road racing. The body would be similar to foundations in other sports, such as the National Golf Foundation. A task force is drafting a plan that is due in mid-April.

Funding for the new organization may come from the running industry, the big races, or both. For now, the Road Runner's Club of America is supporting the fledgling group's logistical efforts.

Optimism ran high following the summit. As *Road Race Management* editor Phil Stewart wrote in his special issue on the summit, "What was remarkable was the singular sense of purpose of the entire group."
