Another Meet Of The Minds?

Now that the road racing community has hashed out its challenges in the recent Road Summit, some are looking back to the similar group-think that got the track & field community talking two years ago.

The Meet of the Minds was funded by Nike, and pushed along by Steve Miller. At the time, it was hailed a success. What has sprouted from it since then?

"Nothing," says Miller. "We followed through, we put the working groups together, but to date there has been little or no resolve and outcome."

Miller, who has been succeeded as Nike's track director by Rudy Chapa, says that another Meet is a probability for next fall, with Chapa organizing it.

Nike wants to see some action, says Miller. "It's not in our interests to pour time and money into something that's going nowhere. And with Atlanta coming up, we feel there is the real prospect of substantive movement forward."

Miller makes his feelings clear that the battle for the sport's future has not been won: "On a personal note," he says, "To justify and glorify track & field in this country based on the performances of the athletes misses the entire point. The sport needs to go forward."

"To say T&F in this country is healthy because our kids have great performances—that doesn't relate. That misses the point."

"It's not one dimension. It has nothing to do with the number of gold or silver medals we have won. We're doing that in spite of ourselves."

The Chinese Get Scarce

This season was to see the Chinese women be unleashed on the road running world, a prospect that had a number of top roadies deeply concerned.

After last fall's record binge, it appeared that more than a few Chinese would be capable of running devastating times on the roads. In addition to the danger posed to the record books, another rash of scintillating performances would endanger the earning power of Western roadies.

We'll have to wait a little longer for this next chapter to be written, as the Chinese

team has unexpectedly pulled out of two April road events.

Ma's Army was slated to run in the Bob Hasan 10K in Jakarta, Indonesia last Sunday, where they stood to win \$500,000 for breaking the women's road WR of 30:38. In a terse fax sent three days before the race, the Chinese Olympic Committee withdrew the runners "for reasons."

The next day, the Chinese Athletic Association informed London Marathon organizers that Ma Junren's elite runners would not compete there on April 17. The fax read, "Due to bad health some elite runners... have not had regular training in recent times." It was felt they would be unable to "bear the marathon."

The withdrawals come less than a week after Wu Shaozu, director of China's sports commission, announced a new offensive on doping in sport. He said he was appalled by the number of top Chinese athletes who have been caught, and was afraid that hopes of "overnight fame and phenomenal fortune" had proven too tempting.

Said Yuan Weimin, director of the national doping center, "There are still people who slight the works of the anti-doping committee."

It is not known whether the withdrawals have anything to do with the anti-doping campaign, but Ma has had a number of well-publicized conflicts with China's sporting hierarchy, and apparently has no shortage of enemies at this point.

Outdoor Poll Debuts

Tennessee and Nebraska rose to the top of the ranks in the first outdoor version of the USTCA/T&FN Coaches Dual Meet Poll.

Doug Brown's Vols rolled to a big lead on the men's side after crushing North Carolina, NC State and Georgetown in a four-way. The as-yet-untested Nebraska and Arkansas squads follow.

The Nebraska women maintained their indoor momentum, eking out a narrow lead over North Carolina. The Vols trail, despite having a close win over the Tarheels.

In coming weeks the polls will alternate, with the men's set for next week. Won-loss records shown are for competitions against over Division I opponents in meets featuring

four or fewer teams (dnc=no dual competition yet). Scores are given as a percentage of a perfect vote, i.e. 100.0 is a unanimous selection as No. 1.
