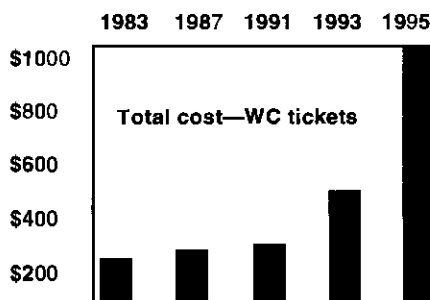

WC Ticket Prices Soaring

If you tried to buy tickets to recent tours by Barbra Streisand or The Eagles, or for the Final Four, or Super Bowl, or whatever, you know that gaining entrance to popular events is getting more ridiculous than ever.

Track, we're sad to report, is not immune from this phenomenon, with next year's Göteborg ducats setting new standards for World Championships expense, as our graph shows.

Using upper-class backstretch tickets



(where TAFNOT tourists usually sit) as our yardstick, you can expect to pay about \$102.50 per day in Sweden.

The extra bad news is that there is no longer a rest day, so you're paying for 9 days of track instead of just 8, and the Opening Ceremonies day is a mandatory part of a complete set of tickets, making it 10 days overall, for a total of some \$1025

Previous WC prices (prices approximate): Helsinki '83 \$250 (\$31.25/day); Rome '87 \$270 (\$33.75); Tokyo '91 \$310 (\$35, with added day for opening); Stuttgart '93 \$550 (\$68.75).

AOY Suspension Revealed

Once again, it has taken a protracted period of time for a drug suspension to wend its way through all the safeguards in USATF's

testing protocol.

Just revealed is the fact that last year's prep AOY, Calvin Harrison, tested positive for pseudoephedrine (one of the "cold medicine" drugs) at last June's National Junior Championships.

The penalty for drugs in this class is a 90-day suspension, although by the time the test was verified, Harrison had already competed in the Pan-Am Junior Championships and U.S. Olympic Festival.

Harrison will lose credit for marks made at all those meets, including his PR 45.07. His all-time best reverts to 45.25, dropping him from No. 2 to No. 4 on the all-time high school list.

Harrison had built up enough credits prior to the suspension that he retains his honor as High School Athlete Of The Year.
