Return To Iffley Road

Oxford, England, May 6—Kip Keino, who never actually held the mile WR, won a handicap race over some of history's biggest names on the Iffley Road track where 40 years earlier Roger Bannister had become the world's first sub-4:00 miler.

Though Bannister fired the starting pistol, only three of his successors as WR holder—Filbert Bayi, Jim Ryun and Peter Snell—actually ran. Keino, who enjoyed a 380y head start, finished in 4:02.7 to win a 280-year-old golden guinea. "It was fun," the 55-year-old Kenyan said, "but the main point was to honor Sir Roger and his special achievement."

The only runner to start from scratch was Eamonn Coghlan. Troubled by a calf injury, he managed only a 4:31.5 for 9th.

Triple-Threat Torrence

Gwen Torrence sees the 1994 season as a timely chance to try all three sprints. "I have the chance to play with them all," she says. "I do want to run a 400 PR and I think the AR is within reach, too."

Torrence says, "The 400 can be a glamour event this year. Jearl [Miles] and Natasha [Kaiser-Brown] were 1-2 in Stuttgart. Maicel [Malone] ranked No. 9 last year. I had one of the fastest splits [49.0 to lead off the Stuttgart 4 x 400 winners]. That was a great confidence-booster for me. Even get Irina Privalova [PR 49.89 in '93] to run it.

"Plus we all know [Olympic champion] Marie-José Pérec is the most talented 400 runner today. I've raced her only once, in '92, and I was scared to death.

"I didn't know what to do or how to do it. I didn't trust my own strength. But it would be a different story now: I know I'm just as strong and as fast as she is."

Torrence concludes, "If Pérec runs the 400 this year, plus all the others, it would be awesome. Get us all together and that would be a race people would want to see."

Mile vs. 1500 At Penn

After Steve Holman ran a 3:36.95 from the front to win the Jumbo Elliott 1500 at Penn, more than a few people wondered, "Why wasn't that a mile?" It would have been a good one. Holman's time would have been about 3:54.3. Altogether, six or seven runners would have been under the still-revered 4:00 barrier.

"I can't believe they didn't have a mile," said Holman. "It's one of the silliest decisions I ever heard of."

The Penn organization allowed USATF's middle distance committee—which paid expenses to leading runners—to set up the race, and the decision on the distance was the committee's, not Penn's.

Admits committee chair John McKenzie, "Initially our thinking really wasn't in terms of making marketing a priority." Not everyone,

notes McKenzie, realizes that the outdoor mile is an acceptable qualifying distance for the NCAA Division I and USATF 1500s.

"I'd say there's a 99% chance we'll change to the mile next year," says McKenzie. "People can readily identify with the mile. The 4:00 mile is the best-known barrier."

Adds Holman, "It's one of the most fundamental of races. The track cognoscenti can relate to the 1500, but the mile still has a great deal of resonance with the public. It would have been great, especially with the 40th anniversary of Bannister's race coming up a week later.

"Even if I didn't run that fast, I'd feel much better about a 3:58 than a 3:40. When you break 4:00, it validates you as a runner. Maybe it's anachronistic, but this is America, and we know what makes us feel good."

UCLA Gets Closer

Following impressive dual wins for both its squads last weekend, UCLA narrowed

the gap between it and Tennessee in the latest USTC&F&N Coaches Dual Meet Poll. Both Bruin squads are at 9-0.
