Reynolds Loses In Court

The IAAF has won the latest round of its four-year old legal battle with Butch Reynolds. A federal appeals court in Cincinnati ruled in mid-May that the December 1992 ruling awarding the quarter-miler a \$27.4 million judgment against the federation was in error.

The appeals court backed the IAAF claim that the Ohio court did not have jurisdiction in the case.

"After today's sentence I feel more at ease about the future of track and field athletics," commented IAAF head Primo Nebiolo. "And I now look with even greater confidence to the great success of the 1996 Olympic Games in Atlanta."

Following the latest ruling, Reynolds faced a late-May deadline to ask the appellate court for a rehearing, or a 90-day deadline to file an appeal with the U.S. Supreme Court. According to Reynolds, his lawyers will continue the fight, which is over his two-year drug suspension as the result of a disputed 1990 test.

"This is not a victory situation," said IAAF spokesman Christopher Winner. "It's a lose-lose situation. The entire affair is obviously to the detriment of athletics. There are no champagne corks being popped."

Aussies Seek Relief

"A great disservice was done to all athletes out of administrative ignorance in 1968. This was especially damaging for a sport which, rightly or wrongly, runs on World Records," says Mike Hurst of the *Sydney Daily Telegraph*, talking about the effect high altitude has on producing sprint/jump marks which are, in essence, illegally wind aided.

Admittedly, even we didn't catch on at first, as it wasn't until 10 years after the rash of stupendous thin-air-aided marks in the Mexico Olympics of '68 that we began putting that damning little (A) on our lists, noting marks made at more than 1000m of altitude.

But catch on we did, and ever since have felt strongly that the IAAF needs to introduce an altitude restriction on World Record performances. Thus it was that we were less than thrilled when Mexico City was chosen as the site for the '97 World Championships.

In the wake of a story Hurst wrote raising

the specter of Mexico City's ungodly '97 performances leaving the '00 Olympic site with the prospect of few WRs in aided events, the Australian federation is now in the process of putting a formal motion before the IAAF to create a separate set of records, altitude and non-altitude.

The Australians are working on a report which they will submit for consideration at the 1995 IAAF Congress in Göteborg. *T&FN* backs the move all the way.

Indy Games Canceled

In a chilling development, the U.S. has lost its only meet on this year's GP "B" circuit, the Indy Games, depriving U.S. athletes of a good chance to pick up valuable GP points. A loss of title sponsorship was the problem.

What's particularly disturbing about the loss of the meet is that it was to be held in Indianapolis. Pessimists have to ask, "If we

can't get it together at USATF's headquarters, what hope do meets elsewhere in the country have?"

The meet is scheduled to return in '95, on the same weekend, says Paula Snow of the International Management Group.

The IAAF says it has no plans to fill the gap in the B circuit, so its roster will be reduced to 8 meets this year.

In another GP-meet development which could have negative ramifications for the U.S., the São Paulo meet, scheduled for May 15, has been moved to May 21.

That puts it the day before the New York Games (a proximity which required a waiver of GP Rules), meaning that the two meets will end up splitting some of the talent.

And once again, American athletes will lose the chance for another meet at which they have traditionally picked up GP points.
