Prep Star Attacked

Kelli White, one of the nation's leading prep sprinters, was attacked in mid-May by a knife-wielding assailant, reports correspondent Keith Conning. A senior at Union City, California's Logan High, White had just finished track practice and was walking across a parking lot when a former team member—who had been expelled from school the previous year—slashed her face.

White had to undergo surgery that left her with 150 stitches. Two weeks later, she won the 100 at her sectional meet in 11.87, finishing 2nd in the 200 in 24.28. Latasha Gilliam of Pittsburg—ironically coached by White's father—won the 200 in 23.62.

Said the elder White, "You have to do what you have to do as a coach. The emotional part, you deal with that later."

The White family is accustomed to sprinting success. Father Willie White ranked No. 4 in the world at 100 in 1957, and finished 6th in the 1960 Olympic Trials. Mother Debbie Byfield ran at the '72 Olympics on Jamaica's 4 x 100, and a year later as a senior at Berkeley High clocked 23.7.

Status Quo

Dawn Dumble reportedly redshirted the collegiate season to get over surgery on both knees. Since then, she has PRed at 58-3/4 (17.76) and 194-3 (59.20). *Minor surgery*, it has been clarified.

While Dumble will return to school next year, she may not be able to snag a school record. **Valeyta Althouse** recently claimed the shot best of 59-5 1/2 (18.12). And incoming frosh **Suzy Powell** may be the biggest threat to the discus standard of 190-2 (57.96), held by **Tracie Millett**.

Milers **Jamie Harris** (Fresno State) and **Jason Pyrah** (BYU) have both come out on the short end of eligibility rulings, and will not compete in Boise.

Last year's prep surprises, twins **Alvin and Calvin Harrison**, have reportedly left Hartnell JC, with an eye toward competing for a club.

Another to leave school is Kansas State's **Francis O'Neill**, who was 4th in last year's NCAA steeple at 8:29.64.

Mary Slaney won't be in Knoxville. Coach Alberto Salazar had promised she would surprise at 5000 and 10,000, and she seemed on track with a 32:38 training run/race in November. But yet another surgery has sidelined her until September.
