Boise Good NCAA Site

Boise, Idaho, June 1-4—"You know," said one impressed observer at the NCAA Championships, "this just might be the secret to keeping this meet as a truly viable competition."

The "secret" to which he referred is using as host sites schools which aren't in large metropolitan areas and/or aren't big-time football/basketball powerhouses. Warm and friendly schools like Boise State, with a populace eager to host a national-class event.

That's just what happened here in Idaho's capital, with a conservative count of almost 35,000 fans coming through the turnstiles during the four days of competition at the 73rd collegiate nationals. It almost matched the 35,600 total claimed by Durham in 1990. They came early and stayed late, and praised field eventers and tracksters alike.

If there was a downside to the whole thing, it would have to be the somewhat

sterile atmosphere of a concrete-and-astroturf football stadium, with the added negative of forcing all the long throws outside the main arena.

The days started hot, with evenings finishing up from cool to warm. As expected, the 818m of altitude—"put those marks on the list with an 'a' instead of an 'A,'" said one statistician—gave help to sprinters and jumpers, and hindered the distance runners.

Afternoons hot, evenings cool. Attendance: 7380/8051/8892/10,493 (34,816).

Men: Arkansas Down

To give you an idea of how much talent is floating around on the Arkansas men's team, look at the May 27 edition's predictions. Arkansas had a bad meet, relatively speaking, with the projected 100 5th, 400 2nd and 10K 3rd not even scoring. Nonetheless, John McDonnell's troops racked up a 38-

point margin of victory, even though their 83 points were far under the 102 we had predicted for them.

Led by Erick Walder's LJ/TJ double, they picked off 5 individual titles, becoming only the sixth school ever to win that many in a single year.

Final Dual Rankings

For 25 years, national dual meet champions have been crowned by *T&FN*, but for the first time, this year the coaches selected the winners themselves.

In Boise at the NCAA meet, the USTCA/T&FN Div. I Coaches Dual Poll concluded with a vote by all the coaches in attendance. The results came as no surprise.

Tennessee, =No. 1 in the last vote by the smaller coaches panel, came out on top of the men's standings. Doug Brown's Vols (3-0) handily topped former co-leader UCLA. For Tennessee, it was the first national dual title in the 25-year history of T&FN's rankings, founded by John Wenos.

"We finally found a way to beat Arkansas!" joked Brown. "In all seriousness, we're very excited about winning our first ever title."

In the women's voting, Jeanette Bolden's Bruin squad retained its lead over Tennessee. The team had compiled a 9-0 dual meet record before placing 3rd in Boise. It was UCLA's third

national dual meet title, the previous one coming in 1988.

"The title is important to our team," said Bolden, "but maybe more important to me as a first-year coach."
