Another Gold Rush

Once again, the "Golden 4" of European track meets—Oslo, Zürich, Brussels, Berlin—will be offering up to 20 one-kilo bars of gold to athletes winning events at each of the competitions. Each bar is worth some \$12,500.

Last year, the bars were split five ways, as Trine Hattestad, Michael Johnson, Nouredine Morceli, Maria Mutola and Sonia O'Sullivan each scored quadrifectas.

The pot may not be divvied up as many ways this time, as the number of events which will be eligible has been sliced from 14 to 10 (men's 100, 800, 110H, 400H, LJ, JT; women's 200, 1500, 100H, LJ).

As in last year's inaugural season, not all the events are among this year's eligible ones on the IAAF/Mobil GP Circuit, to which all of the meets belong.

The top prize money for each Golden 4 meet has also been raised, from \$6000 to \$7000. The increased money is as a result of successful TV marketing of the series by the German firm, UFA.

To help ensure the success of this year's series and its televising, the meets have been signing athletes to contracts to compete in all four meets.

Some of the matchups already announced are intriguing indeed: Christie vs. Fredericks and Mitchell in the 100; Jackson vs. McKoy in the 110H; JJK vs. Drechsler in the long jump.

Other meets (London and Monaco have been prominently cited) are eager to join the series, but UFA says that's unlikely before the '96 campaign.

No Holding Hands

At the 17M mark of May's Toronto Marathon, Canadians Peter Fonseca and Peter Maher had left the field behind, and after each tried to break the other, they came to an agreement. Rather than race all-out for the win, they decided to tie and evenly split the \$24,000 for 1st and \$12,000 for 2nd, settling for \$18K each.

"Both of us need the money and we weren't going to run fast times anyway so we decided to split it," explained Maher. With 4km left, Fonseca cramped and was unable to keep up, finishing 2nd. Maher, after winning, insisted he would still split the money.

"I am a man of my word," he said.

"We've both got the Commonwealth Games coming up," he added. "I'd say we were smart about the whole thing."

The two, neither of whom has major sponsorship, were taken aback by the reaction of race director John Craig, who withheld their checks.

"The integrity of the event suffers if an athlete comes here to take the money but wants to save himself for another race down the road," Craig said. "We like Peter very much but right now we feel very much like we've been let down by him." The Ontario Track & Field Association is investigating the situation.

Said Maher, "It is very upsetting to have won the race and then be made to feel like a criminal. Our goals are loftier than just that event."

Two Meets To South Africa

Adding fuel to rumored future bids for the World Championships and/or Olympic Games, South Africa has been awarded two major championships by the IAAF.

First up will be the 1996 World Cross Country Championships, which are going to Cape Town. In 1998, the World Cup will be staged in Johannesburg (and its not-insignificant 1753m of altitude).

Cape Town beat out Vilamoura, Portugal, for the harrier race, while Johannesburg's bid was unopposed.
