Cassell Pushes Term Limits

If Ollan Cassell has his way, the IAAF presidency will soon be subject to term limits. The USATF executive director made the suggestion at a meeting of the USATF board of directors following the national championships in Knoxville.

Cassell also urged the IAAF to start including athletes and meet organizers on more of its committees.

"The idea is to open up the organization to more elements of track & field," said Cassell, an IAAF vice-president who is constantly the object of rumors of running against Primo Nebiolo next year.

He gave no details on how long of a term limit he felt was appropriate, or whether he would make an official proposal at the next IAAF Council meeting.

A German Boycott?

Olympic champions Dieter Baumann and Heike Drechsler, following their wins at the European Cup, have threatened to boycott the World Cup unless their federation comes up with payment for them to compete.

The two—among Germany's most prominent athletic heroes—presented their ultimatum in no uncertain terms.

"That was the last time I run in such an event without some financial concessions by the federation," said Baumann.

"If the DLV comes up with some ideas, I might make myself available," said Drechsler.

The federation has already committed to passing on to the athletes the \$1000 each it receives from the IAAF for their participation.

Changes For Walks

The IAAF Council has voted to remove the walks from its indoor championship slate, following a recommendation of its Race-walking Working Group.

A number of procedural changes were also approved. Communications on the race course will be streamlined so that reports of warnings and disqualifications would be transmitted more quickly to athletes and judges.

Also, there will be new rules for judges to determine whether walkers are in contact with the ground at all times. Walkers will now be required to touch the ground on each step

with their heels first.

The Council did not approve the walk committee's recommendation to increase the women's championship distance from 10,000m to 20,000m while increasing the men's 20,000m to 30,000m.

Lebow A Hall Of Famer

Fred Lebow, the man who transformed the New York City Marathon from a small local affair into one of the world's great road races, will soon enter into the National Track & Field Hall Of Fame.

Lebow was given the nod in a special vote by the USATF Executive Committee in its Knoxville meeting, and was granted a waiver by the Hall's board of directors so that he could bypass the usual nomination, election and induction process.

New York will be the site of the induction ceremony for Lebow, who suffered a recurrence of lymphoma of the brain in February.

Oly Fest Reduction

In a cost-cutting move, the USOC Board of Directors has eliminated one Olympic Festival in every Olympic quadrennium. Since 1978 the meet has been staged in all the non-Olympic years, but now there will only be two Festivals between the Games, instead of three.

The decision will save the USOC \$4.2 million, which is the approximate cost of each Festival. It hasn't been determined yet which of the coming editions will be canceled, 1997 or 1998.

In another cost-cutting move, organizers of the track portion of the Festival have eliminated three events: the men's 50K walk and 10,000m runs for men and women. "We had to eliminate 40 people," said track commissioner Phil Henson. "So we cut 20 athletes and 20 staffers; we're at rock bottom now."

To compensate for the lost events, each region will be able to enter three athletes in the 20K walk, instead of the typical two. The 5000 for men and 3000 for women will also have three athletes from each region, some selected from the USATF 10,000s.

The events to be cut were chosen after consultation with USATF. While the need for cuts was financial, the choices were made "partly because of the heat," explained Henson.
