## JUCO Limits Foreigners

The nation's JC coaches have voted to limit foreign scholarships to 8 per school, a move strongly opposed (surprise!) by Blinn College's Steve Silvey.

"It's simple discrimination," he says. "This sort of thing has been attempted in the NCAA but has gotten shot down every time."

Blinn, which won the JUCO nationals this year with 235 points, got 116 points from 10 foreign athletes. Because of the new rule, which goes into effect immediately, Silvey has placed a notice in the JC coaches newsletter saying that he has athletes available for placement with other schools.

"It's a shame," he adds. "The foreign athletes are the best role models I could have on my team. They're hard workers on the track and in the classroom. They're appreciative."

## Top Coaching Jobs Filled

Three of the top jobs in the collegiate coaching ranks have been recently filled after the retirements of big-name coaches.

The USC post, vacated by Jim Bush, will be filled by Ron Allice. The coach at Long Beach City College, Allice was at Long Beach State prior to that. This year his men's team tied for the win at the Cal JC meet.

The Villanova position, formerly held by Marty Stern, goes to his assistant, John Marshall. A 1984 Olympian at 800, Marshall has coached the school's sprinters and middle distance runners for the last two years.

The Washington State men's head coaching job that once belonged to John Chaplin goes to his longtime assistant, '68 Olympian Rick Sloan.

## Row Over Kiwi Black

In the United States, a change in the national uniform elicits little more than fashion commentary. That's a marked contrast

from New Zealand, where leaked plans to change the uniform of the national track team have ignited a strong protest.

Apparently, New Zealand's Olympic and Commonwealth Games Association plans to replace the famous all-black uniform with the blue and green of a corporate sponsor.

Calling the plan to do away with the traditional black an insult, John Walker said, "We have had it for years and years and we are known world-wide because of that single. It is New Zealand.

"If the black were changed, there would be a public outcry."

Said Peter Snell, "It would be a pity to do away with it. Our athletic performances are becoming more nondescript and what you would get here is a nondescript uniform to

finish it off."

Walker added, "You don't see the All-Blacks [rugby team] changing to pink and yellow, yet they have gone out and got their sponsorship and kept the traditional design."

## '96 Training Camps Previewed

Four college facilities are in the running to be selected as the training base for the '96 U.S. Olympic track team.

Central Florida (Orlando), North Carolina (Chapel Hill), North Carolina State (Raleigh), Tennessee (Knoxville) are the schools/cities under consideration.

USATF representatives got a good look at Knoxville during the USATF Championships, and will evaluate the other sites in July.

## Altitude Records

No one questions that altitude affects the distances as well as the sprints. The 800, however, is short enough that it is aided. The times here for 800-1000 are included for informational purposes. At 1500/Mile, the aid/hindrance question might be a wash, at least in a competition without heats. At longer distances, the effects of thinner air undoubtedly hinder athletes.
