No More Last Chances?

The last-chance meets could be all but dead, if a ruling by the Division I subcommittee of the NCAA Track & Field Committee sticks. The subcommittee has voted to allow qualifying marks for nationals only through May 20, with conference meets being permitted an additional day.

In addition, all qualifying meets must be certified by the NCAA. Qualifying dates for the indoor meet were left unchanged. The rule goes into effect next season.

That was just one of many significant developments to come out of the mid-June committee meeting in Kansas City, Missouri:

- The Div. I Indoor meet in Indianapolis will incorporate the full slate of Div. II championship events in 1995 (and maybe thereafter). Div. II's earlier recommendation of the Air Force Academy for its own site was deferred by the Executive Committee, which asked the track group to study the feasibility of combining the meets.

- As expected, the women's hammer is on its way. Both the 20lb weight indoors and the 4kg hammer outdoors may soon be on the championship schedule. Div. I proposes adding the events in '96, contingent on the executive committee allowing a corresponding increase in the number of overall meet entries.

Div. II plans to add the events next season. Div. III has already incorporated the hammer, but plans to add the indoor weight in '96.

- Recommended sites for the Div. I outdoor champs are Bloomington '97 and Buffalo '98. (Next year will be in Knoxville, and '96 in Eugene.)

Harris Nixed, Brits Not

Veteran U.S. 400 hurdler Danny Harris has been ordered by the IAAF to resume his four-year doping suspension, even though he competed in five Grand Prix meets this summer after being reinstated by USATF.

Harris had been suspended in 1992 after testing positive for cocaine, but was reinstated by the U.S. federation in March after an appeal. Harris, now 29, went through a three-month drug rehabilitation program.

IAAF Secretary Istvan Gyulai said USATF had no right to reinstate Harris. "He cannot

compete anywhere until his four-year suspension is complete," said Gyulai. "Only the IAAF Council has the authority to consider a request for reinstatement."

A USATF appeals board cleared Harris to compete as of March 1 and executive director Ollan Cassell claims he informed the IAAF. Gyulai said the decision was never passed on.

While refusing to comment on whether any action would be taken against USATF, Gyulai did say he believed the U.S. body acted in good faith.

But he reiterated, "We have never received anything requesting reinstatement because of exceptional circumstances. So he remains suspended until his penalty has expired."

Meanwhile, the director of Stockholm's Grand Prix meet asked for disciplinary action to be taken against British stars Linford Christie, Sally Gunnell and John Regis after the trio were late withdrawals from the meet.

Rajne Soderberg asked that the athletes

be barred from the London and Nice meets, claiming he had the assurance of their agent Andy Norman that they would run.

The British federation supported the athletes, spokesman Tony Ward noting, "Linford never confirmed he would run in Stockholm. Sally had a back injury and John a knee problem. Both had medical evidence."

The three ultimately were allowed to continue competing—although Christie suffered a slight tear to his right hamstring in a losing effort to Jon Drummond in London's 100. The Olympic and World champ now will miss the Goodwill Games.

According to the Hungarian Tables, Ondieki's total of 2505 puts him only 9 points ahead of his young challenger. Khalid Skah has also moved up recently, his big 5000 PR giving him the No. 3 spot here.
