Then There Were Two

Last year, the 20 bars of gold available in the Golden 4 series were split five ways. At most, they'll just be split in two this year.

Ten events are in the setup this year: men's 100, 800, 110H, 400H, LJ, JT; women's 200, 1500, 100H, LJ. Of the 10 Oslo winners, only 4 (Wilson Kipketer 800, Colin Jackson 110H, Derrick Adkins 400H and Mike Powell LJ) were able to win in Zürich.

The roster of potential winners was halved again in Brussels, as Kipketer and Adkins bit the dust. That leaves Jackson (who is undefeated this year) and Powell in the running, with only Berlin (August 30) to go.

Grassroots Problems

Congressional hearings in early August reviewed the Amateur Sports Act of 1978, and there were some very negative notes sounded.

Tom McMillen, co-chair of the President's Council on Physical Fitness & Sports, said that he's worried about a decline in the grassroots programs of American sport, saying that physical fitness standards of American children have declined since the act was passed.

"It disturbs me how our system pays a professional athlete \$50 million but ignores the health needs of children in our inner cities and the rest of the nation."

Rep. Dennis Hastert (R-Ill) expressed concern over how universities are interpreting the gender-equity issues mandated by Title IX of the Act.

Said Hastert, "Increasingly, athletic directors are opting to eliminate minor sports programs for men in order to comply with the Title IX rules, rather than create new sports opportunities for women."

Hastert noted that men's gymnastics had 138 college teams in 1976, and only 31 today, and that the nationals have been canceled.

Hands Off USATF Logo

USATF's distinctive logo, the inverted triangle with the large "USA" across it, is becoming very popular. Too popular, in fact, as USATF has noted many instances of piracy, particularly by high schools and colleges.

The imitators typically change the red,

white and blue logo to their school colors, and replace "USA" with the school name.

USATF officials note, "USATF has made a substantial investment in its trademarks and service marks, and has a duty to protect them. Unauthorized and unlicensed uses dilute the value and marketability of the logo and hampers our ability to promote the sport."

The logo is a registered trademark, protected under federal and state laws and USATF says it will "take action to protect its rights" against violators. Anyone having a question about the use of the logo should contact USATF's national office at 317/261-0500.

The Battle Of Atlanta

According to Bert Roughton Jr. of the *Atlanta Constitution*, IAAF head Primo Nebiolo has had his first confrontation with the Atlanta organizers, and come out on the short end.

Said Roughton of a June meeting, "[Nebiolo] looked across the room at Atlanta Olympics chief Billy Payne and asked for 1% of all tickets free of charge for his international federations. That's more than 100,000 tickets worth maybe \$5 million.

"While this angered others in the Atlanta contingent, Payne kept his cool and politely said no. No because Atlanta isn't giving away tickets.

"Privately they fear Nebiolo could turn scalper with the tickets or may use them to play big shot with sponsors of his sports while Olympic sponsors are being asked to buy their tickets."

LA Rumors Resurface

For years, conspiracy buffs have insisted that a batch of positive drug tests (not linked to any particular sport) from the LA Olympics were suppressed.

The decade-old claim got new life in late August when a BBC program produced new claims of a cover-up. Two chemists told the British network that nine positive tests were never acted upon. All the documentation was reportedly mysteriously shredded, so there is no possibility of ever knowing who the positives were, if the story is true.

An IOC source told Reuters, "1984 is a long time ago. We're concentrating on what happens now, in 1994, and in the future."

New East Bloc Rumors

The German daily *Berliner Zeitung* has published an article claiming that East Germany and the Soviet Union engaged in a little bit of mutual back-scratching in 1979 and '80. Maybe back-stabbing is more like it.

According to the article, the lab in Kreischa, East Germany, turned up a positive test on a Soviet woman middle-distance runner in 1979, and on 10 weightlifters from a '79 meet. Rather than report these positives, however, the East German apparatus used the information to pressure the Soviets into being lenient on any East German positives which might show up at the '80 Olympics in Moscow.

The article was written by biology professor Werner Franke, who said he found the information while searching files of the old East German secret police, the Stasi.

Missing Sprinters

Dennis Mitchell's hands are apparently as fast as his feet. Just ask Nigerian sprinter Olapade Adeniken, who had to skip the Brussels meet after a dustup with the American in Zürich. Adeniken needed stitches to close a cut over one eye after his post-meet encounter with Mitchell.

Said Zürich spokesman Patrick Magyar, "There was a disagreement over some personal matter and they both over-reacted very stupidly." Mitchell just reacted quicker.

Also missing from Brussels was Leroy Burrell, a non-factor in the big Zürich race. Burrell said he felt pain in his right foot in the Zürich heats, and it got worse in the final. It's a ligament problem of some sort, and the WR holder is not expected to run again this year.

Burrell's teammate, Carl Lewis, was missing from the Zürich festivities. Lewis cited a stomach problem picked up at the Goodwill Games, and headed back to the States.

Ondieki Out For Season

Yobes Ondieki has added injury to insult. First countryman William Sigei stole his 10K WR; now Ondieki has a bad stress fracture.

"My doctor said there is only one option for me: to rest," said the Kenyan star after pulling out of the Zürich 5000. "I believe that my season is finished."
