Drug Penalties To Lessen?

The pendulum may be swinging back toward a more liberal stance on drug penalties.

"I think a 2-year ban is the most productive solution for a doping case," IOC head Juan Antonio Samaranch said at a conference in Romania in mid-October. Samaranch went on to say that he felt that lifetime bans did nothing to stop the use of illegal drugs and also voided any chance to "improve the behavior" of those who have taken banned substances.

The IAAF increased its first-time steroid-abuse penalty from 2 years to 4 at its '91 Congress in Tokyo. There was a move to go back to 2 years at the Stuttgart meeting in '93, but in an emotion-packed setting that suggestion was turned down.

IAAF head Primo Nebiolo has expressed the opinion that he would go along with a return to the lesser penalty.

800 Number Gets Partner

There are plenty of fans out there hungering for track information—and they know how to use the telephone.

The 800 number set up by Vic Holchak completed a successful second stint this summer. "We received more than 98,000 calls this year," says the Los Angeles-based Holchak, "bringing the total to nearly 193,000 over the two summers." Callers have rung up more than 532,000 minutes on the Mobil-backed service.

A new facet of Holchak's service in '94 was a paid-by-the-caller 900 number, which featured longer reports than the 800 line. He says, "Phone people said if the 900 number got 5% of the volume of calls on the 800 line, that would be considered a success. The 900 number hit peaks of 11-12% and all summer averaged just over 10%."

But the volume of 900 calls caused technical problems that put the system down several times. So Holchak expanded his reports on the 800 line. "It was hard to get a real idea just how successful the 900 number was," he says. "We know we can do better with it, but we have to iron out the technical glitches."

Holchak says he is eagerly looking ahead to '95 and expects to continue and expand his offerings. He is considering ideas like a weekly service during the indoor season, beginning outdoor coverage late in the U.S. season, and encompassing the entire European

summer rather than just the second half as in the past two years.

"We have track fans calling like mad," Holchak says. "Now we want to bridge the gap to the general sports fans."

McColgan Quite The Skeptic

Liz McColgan was the '91 world champ in the 10,000, but she has little use for the woman who succeeded her as holder of that title. Nor does she think much of the accomplishments of Wang Junxia's fellow Chinese.

"They're not in my reality," the 30-year-old Scot said in mid-October. Speaking of Wang's WR 29:31.78 she said, "That's not what I see the World Record as. It's making a laughingstock of the records."

"My goal is still the 30:00 barrier. The 30:00 barrier is for the clean athletes. The way it is just now, you should have two Olympics; one for the clean athletes, one for the druggies."

McColgan, an Alabama alum, said she wasn't at all surprised when Ma's Army didn't show up at the major races of 1994: "I read all the stories about the Chinese running on the Grand Prix Circuit and in the London Marathon, but I knew from the outset that they were not going to turn up."

McColgan also turned her ire on her teammates, saying, "I don't think we in Britain have been as honest as we should be. There's people you know are doing it and they never seem to get caught. They must have friends in high places."

She was also critical of the British testing system, saying that she hadn't been tested at all in the last two years while she was out with injuries. "If I were that way [taking drugs] inclined I could have come back and run 27:00 or so and no one would be any the wiser."

Pérec May Try Hurdles

Olympic/World 400 champ Marie-José Pérec has long talked about a move to the 400 hurdles. Pérec's plans have now moved beyond the trial-balloon stage. She told *L'Équipe*, "My aim next year is to beat both Sally Gunnell and the World Record. I think that a career without a World Record is incomplete."

A 48.83 racer on the flat, Pérec has dabbled with the barriers in the past, setting a PR of 55.76 in '89. Britain's Gunnell set the WR of 52.74 in winning in Stuttgart; her flat PR is 51.11, though she does have sub-50 relay carries.

Part of Pérec's idea in aiming at the hurdle

record is her belief that no matter how well she runs on the flat she might not be able to break the WR of 47.60 held by Marita Koch.

"Since Seoul, I'm the only woman to break 49 seconds," says the French star. "Some who used to run that fast now run 51. It makes you think." Pérec is =No. 5 on the all-time list; the four runners ahead of her are Eastern Europeans who got their bests in '85 or earlier.

Spivey & Wessinghage Twins

One of the more unexpected marks of the year was Jim Spivey's PR 13:15.86 in the Berlin 5000 at age 34. Spivey's old best was 13:19.24, and that was produced way back in 1983.

Coming as it did at the end of a solid—but unspectacular—season, the PR was a surprise to just about everybody. One who wasn't surprised was one of Spivey's coaches, Mike Durkin. Durkin figured Spivey would run 13:10-13:15, based on a comparison of Spivey's PRs with those of former German miler Thomas Wessinghage. "He was right, as usual," says Spivey.

Drechsler On For '95 Multis

Heike Drechsler's first heptathlon in 13 seasons—a '94-pacing 6741 at Talence—has convinced the German star to contest the multis in 1995's title meets.

The ace long jumper announced in October that she plans to enter the pentathlon at the World Indoor and the heptathlon in Göteborg. The 29-year-old Drechsler also plans to long jump.

The outdoor Worlds, of course, sets up the potential of a titanic duel between Drechsler and WR holder Jackie Joyner-Kersey. The two have been career-long rivals in the long jump, but have never met in a multi.

Of the outdoor double, her coach and father-in-law Erich Drechsler says, "The schedule will allow her to jump and then do the heptathlon. If it had been the other way around, we wouldn't go for the double."
