JJK Athlete Of The Year

Jackie Joyner-Kersey won her third women's A.O.Y. title, but it didn't come easily, as the voting was the wildest in history.

Runner-up Maria Mutola received more votes in places 1 and 2 than did JJK. So did Sonia O'Sullivan as No. 3.

More voters tabbed O'Sullivan as their No. 1 than any other athlete, yet a slew of voters saw her as a weaker candidate than either Mutola or Kersey, and the Irishwoman ended up relegated to the No. 3 spot. O'Sullivan, in fact, received votes in every position from 1 to 10.

Placers 2-3-4 (Mutola, O'Sullivan & Sally Gunnell) each got more No. 1 votes, and No. 5 Gwen Torrence got as many as JJK, who is the first athlete (man or woman) to win with such a handicap. She received a mere 9.7% of the votes for the No. 1 position.

What JJK didn't get were low votes, which all the others did.
