No JJK/Drechsler Multi

Exciting as the prospect may have been, don't hold your breath for a Heike Drechsler-Jackie Joyner-Kersey clash in this summer's World Champs heptathlon.

Drechsler is virtually certain to pass up the Worlds 7-eventer, she revealed at Millrose, explaining, "The timing is terrible."

The big stumbling block for the German long jump star is the timing of the meets the German federation considers primary in its selection process for the Göteborg heptathlon.

"Götzis is the main meet," said Erich Drechsler, Heike's coach/father-in-law. The Euro Cup also gets consideration, but not as much in the eyes of German selectors as the high-powered Austrian meet.

But Götzis is scheduled for May 27-28, too early in Heike's overall track season. And the Euro Cup is July 1-2—right in the middle of Germany's track nationals (June 30-July 2).

So, despite Drechsler's list-leading 6741 last year, expect her to concentrate on her single-event specialty.

"It's OK to do just one heptathlon a year. You can go and just have fun in it," Heike said when asked if she might consider a lone effort at season's end like Talence last year.

"But when you are very serious about the heptathlon, it means much, *much* training."

Indoor Track Important

"The best method yet conceived for promoting track & field in the United States is the indoor season.

"Although many critics have pointed out that this nation is approaching the end of its domination in the Olympic Games, the format for continued success is, and has been, in operation for about half a century.

"In contrast to the outdoor meets, the directors of the great indoor spectacles held annually in Eastern cities realize that the sport is based upon healthy individual competition. These promoters strive to bring the best athletes in the U.S. together in weekly presentations.

"From January through March, the series of meets develops new stars and

intense competition. Most of the really great American runners have toured the board trail...

"What must be done now is to transmit this procedure to the outdoor campaign. We need sectional invitational meets; we need a spring series of competitions for post-graduate athletes; we need to promote track & field for the non-collegian."

Good points, eh? As the French would say, *plus ça change, plus c'est la même chose* (the more things change, the more they stay the same): those words were penned by track expert Dwain Esper in the December 1955 issue of *Track & Field News*.

Spanish Civil War?

An offer by Madrid to take over the 1997 World Championships—should Mexico City's problems prove insurmountable—is undoubtedly not sitting well in another part of Spain.

The Madrid regional government said in early February that the Spanish capital could bring facilities up to championship standard at little expense.

The problem is that another Spanish city, Seville, is an active bidder for the '99 Worlds, and views the staging of that meet as an important stepping stone in its bid to become an acceptable Olympic site.

Critic's Corner: Reno TV

Installment No. 2 in USATF's 5-meet television series proved what diehard fans have always known: that good track makes the best TV. The inaugural Reno Games may not have been the Olympics, but Reno gripped the viewer persuasively enough to perhaps convince a few couch taters to give track a chance.

Much of what was pleasing was purely visual. The Reno Livestock Center and the broad oval of the Bill Cosby Track helpfully afforded camera angles—particularly for the field events—that brought across the athletes' power and grace. This simply meant one camera could pull back in a side view that emphasized distance and height—Kenny Harrison bounding over vast expanses of runway in the TJ or Bill Payne shooting up, even in a miss, to AR altitudes in the vault.

Another key sensory ingredient pumping up Reno was the crowd. On the aforementioned Payne vault miss, fans could be seen and heard hooting and hollering in the background. It's encouraging to see track television get and use a chance to exploit the kind of clapping, cheering infectious enthusiasm that is part and parcel of even trash sports shows of the *American Gladiators* ilk.

And, of course, there was spandex. Yes, track's too well-kept secret, it's bounty harvest of beautiful bodies, male and female in a variety of shapes and sizes, could be in danger of getting out. And there are faces

worth watching, as well. Match Jackie Joyner-Kersey and Susen Tiedtke-Green in tiddlywinks and you'd get great visuals.

Announcer Tom Hammond and his color commentators, Carol Lewis and Craig Masback, had an outing free of major misspeak. It helped that this is a series, meaning last week's results could inform this week's introductions. Field event announcer Dwight Stones served well, as usual. Above that, Masback helpfully took care to clarify Reno's altitude's performance-distorting effects.

Prerecorded interviews, all with a consistent, up-to-date look and feel are an asset in the series so far. One such clip shown in a small window during the 800 caught Mark Everett declaring that he now knows he's going to win every race he runs. He promptly went on to finish 5th. That's good, though—a running mouth is hardly a liability in sports TV these days. Just ask Dennis Rodman.

A visit to Michael Johnson's environs in Waco was well done and Johnson, of course, aided its impact by living up to its billing. Now we know his secret: Texas barbecue.
