Vault Rank Problems

A late announcement of a drug DQ has forced the modification of the 1994 women's World Rankings in the pole vault, and removed a World Record.

Nicole Rieger (Germany) and Sun Caiyun (China) both jumped 13-4¹/₂ (4.08) at Karlsruhe, Germany, on March 11 of 1994. Rieger's was the only mark ratified as a WR, however, as Sun turned up positive for a

drug in the stimulant category, which earned her a 3-month ban.

The removal of affected marks makes Sun's seasonal record such that she drops from No. 2 in the Rankings to No. 3, with Germany's Andrea Müller moving up a slot.

What's even worse, is that we may have to reconsider the ordering again, with Sun perhaps moving back up! This is predicated on the recent release of late-fall Chinese lists which indicate that post-suspension she may have twice vaulted an outdoor WR 13-6¹/₂ (4.12). Getting information out of China is still no easy task.

We also need to modify the women's shot rankings, with previously unlisted Zhung Lihong climbing into the No. 3 position now that her season has been correctly compiled.

Critic's Corner: Cleveland

Regrettably, a clause in Homer Simpson's Fox TV contract barred him from critiquing the Mobil Indoor Track & Field series' KeyCorp Classic program. Instead, your reviewer solicited the help of a trained analyst: an English Lit Ph.D. student.

And what thought my lit-crit friend? Well, after a few standard post-race athlete interviews, she appeared a trifle dissatisfied and observed that novelist Kathy Acher once said that after taking up exercise herself she developed empathy for athletes given the impossible task of being articulate or insightful on the tube immediately after competition.

It's a point to consider. In track TV, athletes are interviewed while winded and without analytical distance. Drop 'em entirely? Nah, but definitely consider their impact.

And what of the sport itself? The triple jump drew a wow-equivalent when Kenny Harrison explained over a slow-mo side view of himself in action that three bounds would take him from home plate to the pitcher's mound. The conclusion: camera angles are crucial, and the series people are right to include athlete quotes that explain the events.

An analyst of literary form, my friend liked the consistent straightaway race presentation pattern of race, slo-mo view, second slow-mo view. She found it hard,

though, to keep track of who was who in the oval races.

And me? I was glad to see progress by announcers Tom Hammond, Carol Lewis and Craig Masback in focusing on true contenders. Unsharp Dennis Mitchell got just a mention before the flat 60. Instead, Henry Neal and Michael Green were correctly pegged based on form as the men to watch.

I was glad to see the window in which prerecorded athlete quotes were rolled during longer races relocated so it no longer obscured the view of the race leaders.

But the journalist in me cringed at the simplification of the Butch Reynolds case. Reynolds was essentially presented as innocent, when, in fact, we don't know that. And the average viewer probably thinks Butch was a lock for gold if he'd only been allowed to go to Barcelona in '92. There are myriad flaws in that picture. For the record, my friend found the whole Reynolds fiasco more complicated than anything she wanted to absorb in a 30-second spiel.
