Lots Of Status Quo

INJURIES, LIVE ON TV!! It's not often you see training accidents on your television set, but those watching the Millrose telecast got to see just that.

Olympic champ **Gail Devers** was doing start work when her left hamstring gave way. In a nice bit of cinema vérité, coach Bobby Kersee's negative verbal reaction is rather audible. . .

Hollis Conway has undergone knee surgery. The AR-holding high jumper dislocated a kneecap and suffered ligament damage during a competition in Germany in January. . .

The IAAF's random testing program nailed two Americans in December—discus thrower **Mike Gravelle** for testosterone and heptathlete **Gea Johnson** for steroids. Facing 4-year bans, both athletes released the requisite pleas of innocence. . .

Conspicuous in her absence from the boards has been star miler **Suzy Hamilton**, sidelined with a stress fracture. . .

UCLA putter Nada Kavar, a Jordanian by birth, became a U.S. citizen in February. A 45-9¹/₄ performer as a prep two years ago, she redshirted last year, then improved by nearly 7 feet with a 52-2³/₄ at the Husker Invitational. . .

Long jumper **Roland McGhee** had to skip the Cleveland meet, as the hamstring problems that limited him to one jump in Madrid the week after his Millrose win acted up.

The former Middle Tennessee standout wants to rest his leg so that he is prepared for the USATF Indoor.

"I have never made a national team," says McGhee, who wants to go to Barcelona. "I was placed on the World Cup team and ran a relay, but I've never qualified for a national team in my event. I've had opportunities and this is one of my best shots." . . .

American JT record holder **Tom Pukstys** has been named an assistant coach at Brown, looking after the throwers. . .

A groin pull kept Mt. St. Mary's **Jim Stevenson** out of the Northeast Conference

Championships in February and may cause the NCAA decathlon favorite to miss the outdoor season. . .

Back training in Indiana after a year in Southern California is hurdler **Glenn Terry**. . . .

ON THE INTERNATIONAL front, lots of retirements to report: Finnish women **Päivi Alafantii (JT)**, **Ringa Ropo (LJ)** and **Satu Ruotsalainen (hept)**; Italian long jumper **Giovanni Evangelisti**; German 800 runner **Christine Wachtel**. . .

Yuko Arimori, the Barcelona marathon silver medalist, underwent surgery on both heels in November. . .

Two former East Bloc nations have re-learned a bit in their attempts to control star athletes. Romania's 3-year ban on high jumper **Galina Astafei** for competing internationally without federation permission has been lifted. Astafei says she will represent Germany once she acquires citizenship.

Bulgaria lifted a ban on hurdler **Svetla Dimitrova**. The federation imposed the ban after Dimitrova left her husband without leaving a forwarding address, which is required by the IAAF Medical Commission. But she was subsequently denied a permit to run in France, apparently because the federation wants some of her winnings. . .

Germany's **Martin Bremmer**, 3rd in the 5000 at last summer's World Cup, has admitted taking testosterone after an October drug test came back positive. German athletic officials have banned him for four years.

Bremmer, 24, says he received the drug from his doctor after a case of hepatitis and shingles stopped the production of natural hormones in his body. . .

Former Euro 400 gold medalist **Grit Breuer** will be eligible to run again this August when she completes her 3-year drug ban.

After switching clubs, the 22-year old Breuer has sights set on the '96 Games. "Atlanta is my big sporting goal. I want to run at a very high level again." . . .

South African 400 hurdler **Myrtle Bothma** fell in the Barcelona final and fractured a hip in two places. After surgery, months in the

hospital recovering and long therapy, she has finally been able to return to training. . .

Despite a severe knee injury and problems with his Achilles since his last race in '92, former Commonwealth 1500 champ **Peter Elliott**, aims to be among Britain's best again when he resumes racing this year.

"I don't believe I can get back to beating Morceli or winning championships," says Elliott, 32. "But I believe I can get back to running the 1500 in the low 3:30s." . . .

Britain's **David Grindley**, who missed the '94 season due to an Achilles injury, is back in training. But he still needs tests to determine if the tendon requires surgery. . .

Sally Gunnell will change her routine as she begins defense of her world 400H title. Instead of her usual winter training in Florida, the WR holder will travel to South Africa this season. "I need something different," she said.

One thing she does not plan to change is her event. "I don't know how the rumor about me trying an 800 got started this year," says Gunnell. "There's no point. Why should you switch when you're running so well at your present event?" . . .

High jump WR holder **Stefka Kostadinova**, 29, gave birth to a boy in January. . .

Canadian sprinter **Bruny Surin** has had a moderate start this indoor season after recovering from a knee injury. "I just need more competitions to get going," says the defending World Indoor champ. . .

Things are definitely not peachy in **Ukraine**. Jumper **Inessa Kravets** and sprinter **Zhanna Tarnopolskaya** are considering emigrating to Israel, both for better training opportunities and because of rising instances of anti-Semitism at home.

And, citing inadequate training facilities, decathletes **Lev Lobodin** and **Vitaliy Kolpakov** have informed the IAAF that they have withdrawn from the World Indoor.
