## ABC Takes Göteborg

Phew! Unlike 1993, when Americans had to wait until the last minute to see if there would be any TV coverage of the World Championships, a deal is already in the bag for Göteborg.

ABC has inked an "unprecedented" pact with the IAAF that will find the American network guaranteeing 7½ hours of coverage from Sweden. But that's not all. In addition, ESPN (I, not the lesser II version) will show 10-12 hours.

But that's still not all. In addition to the heady number of hours from Göteborg, ESPN will be carrying a full slate of IAAF events, starting with a 3-hour package from March's World Indoor in Barcelona.

Scheduled for 1-hour shots this year are the World Cross Country Champs, the World Marathon Cup, the World Walk Cup, the GP

Final and the World Half-Marathon Champs.

In announcing the pact, IAAF head Primo Nebiolo said, "One of our main goals has been to help the sport of track & field gain greater exposure in the United States.

"This contract will help publicize the great athletes of the United States, who are among the greatest in any sport but possibly the least known. We would like to change this and put track in its proper place among the U.S. sports."

## Great Track Day On TV

Mark down June 4 on your calendar as a Sunday afternoon with no shortage of track on the tube. CBS and Nike have a big day planned.

First up is 90 minutes worth of the NCAA Championships from Knoxville.

Then there's an hour special titled, *Fire On The Track: The Prefontaine Story Presented by Nike*. This is a special bio presentation on legendary Steve Prefontaine. Publicity releases say it features "rare footage" of the former Oregon star in action as well as interviews with many of Pre's contemporaries.

The extrackvaganza will conclude with a 90-minute telecast of this year's Pre Classic, which will be a CBS/Nike co-venture.

Projected time for the whole affair is 2:00-6:00 Eastern Time, but as they say, check your local listings (and pray you don't fall victim to the dreaded b-word: blackout).

## Ricoh's \$25K Winners

With the staging of the Stockholm meet (following Stuttgart, Liévin and Birmingham), the inaugural Ricoh Indoor Tour came to a close.

And with the close of the series came the awarding of six prizes of \$25,000 each. The winners were Linford Christie (60), Darnell Hall (400), Moses Kiptanui (3000), Yoelvis Quesada (TJ), Irina Privalova (60) and Ellen van Langen (800).

The prizes were awarded on the basis of the best three-mark total in the four meets. Hall was the only one to win all four meets.

## Names In The News

Defending World XC champ William Sigei will not be running to protect his title later this month. A recurring ankle problem has Kenya's 10K WR holder on the shelf.

Look for WR-setting straightaway sprinter Irina Privalova in the 400 at the World Indoor. Russian federation head Valentin Bolakhnichev says, "This is the distance she is fastest over at the moment and I think she will win with a World Record."

Amy Wickus sat out the Big 10 Indoor so that she could recover from a mild case of Achilles tendinitis. Says Wisconsin coach Peter Tegen, "We didn't think it would be too smart to have her run there, because she has more important things coming up."

Florida State's versatile sprint/hurdle star, Philip Riley, skipped the USATF Indoor because of a hyperextended knee. He incurred the injury in the semis at the ACC when he went through a door behind the padding at the end of the straight and slid on the concrete.

Two years ago, after major knee surgery, Tennessee's Sue Walton was told by doctors to stick to sprinting and give up on the long jump, where she had a best of 20-10¾. But after a long rehabilitation, doctors have given her the green light to jump once again.

"She's protecting the joint on takeoffs and landings now," says Vol coach Dorothy Doolittle. "She really feels—and I agree—that the long jump is one of the most fickle events in the Olympic Trials, and that her chances of making the team are best there."

Wisconsin's frosh high jump star, Jeremy Fischer, had to pass on his big event at the Big 10 after aggravating his back in the long jump the previous day. "It's nothing major," assures Wisconsin mentor Ed Nuttycombe.

"Ma Junren's eyebrow is scarred and his nose is askew but he is still in good spirits," said a Chinese newspaper in early March. Despite the disbandment of his former army, Ma is about to get back into the coaching business. He has a new seven-member team, with 1500 WR holder Qu Yunxia the only holdover from the glory days.
