Men

Undeclared 400 WR setter Michael Johnson was an easy choice as men's AOY.

The runner-up position came down to a tight battle between Moses Kiptanui and Vénuste Niyongabo. Niyongabo actually won the only meeting between the two, but Kiptanui got the nod.

Honorable mention: Javier Sotomayor, Linford Christie and Allen Johnson.

U.S. AOY: Johnson.

Schwald Wins One

"It's about time," says Sarah Schwald, of finally winning a national championship (NCAA 3K). "Every year I've gotten better and better. Last year I PRed in all three of my events. But a lot of people didn't classify me as a national-class collegian. That just added fuel to my fire."

A low-mileage trainer in high school, she attempted 50M weeks when she arrived at Arkansas in 1992. It didn't take long for a painful foot ailment to sideline her from cross country and indoor track. Months (and many doctors) later, the pain was finally diagnosed as a navicular fracture. She had the surgery done in Seattle by the doctor who performed the same operation on de-

cathlete Dave Johnson several weeks later.

Since then, Schwald has steadily improved, thanks to a Razorback program that lets her train her way. "Some of the girls on the team run as much 80 miles a week," Schwald says, hesitantly admitting that her track season average maxes out at 28. "It's a little bit beyond 'low-mileage.' And the off-season," she says, "is basically off."...

Names In The News

LSU coach Pat Henry, talking about track & field in the *Baton Rouge Advocate*: "Our sport is too pure. No controversies; no fights. I think our society has changed where pure performance is involved. They want a show."

"I talked to someone about athletes jumping 7-5. They might watch a kid jump and spike a ball over a volleyball net and think the kid's jumping up pretty high. Yet our guy is going 7-5, three inches higher than a volleyball net—and he's putting his entire body over it. I just don't think people can relate to performance. They relate to Red beating Green or Green beating Purple."...

UTEP coach Bob Kitchens had to count himself among the surprised when senior sprinter Melinda Sergent won the NCAA 55. "It wasn't something we planned," he says. "I think the key was that she was able to stay relaxed at the end."

"I've coached a lot of sprinters, but she's the best woman I've ever worked with. She might be capable of 11.1 this year."...

"Not too many people have improved 8 feet in the triple jump in one year," says Blinn's Tom Lester of soph Leonard Cobb, who's still just 19.

The 6-1³/₄/172 Cobb came out of high school (Texas, Texarkana, Texas) with PRs of only 23-10¹/₂ and 46-6. "Mark Napier [former Blinn assistant now at Wisconsin] spotted him at the state meet. Mark's got a pretty good eyeball for talent," says Lester.

In his first year at Blinn, Cobb improved to 25-2³/₄ and 54-7¹/₂. The latter mark earned him a silver at the World Juniors.

"A lot of the credit goes to Lance Veazey, who was our jumps coach last year," says Lester. "At first we thought Cobb might have potential in the high jump, but now we don't want to risk screwing up his horizontals."

"Leonard has really improved his leg speed and body strength. He has a lot more in him." A PR of 55-7¹/₂ in mid-March attests to that. . .

The surprise winner of the women's Junior race at the World Cross Country, was Finland's Annemari Sandell, who's still just 18. Sandell spent the weeks prior to the meet training at altitude with the Kenyan team. Sandell was 4th in the 3000 at last year's World Junior Champs. . .

Despite her impressive wins in her last two 400 outings (last September's World Cup, and now the World Indoor), Irina Privalova says she's sticking with the 100. "Why that distance? Simply because the 100m title remains the most prestigious in track. Everyone always remembers who the 100m champion is, rarely the others."

"So, that was the last 400 of the season, unless Russia has a chance to win the relay gold in Göteborg."...

Speaking of 1-lap races, it's still unclear what discipline France's Marie-José Pérec will choose in Göteborg. She was originally talking about a 400/400H double, but now that she has discovered that the hurdle heats are just an hour before the flat final, she says one event only. But we still don't know which. . .

The Japanese have named their marathon teams for the Worlds: men—Toshiaki, Kurabayashi, Daisuke Tokunaga and one to be named; women—Sachiyo Seiyama, Yukari Komatsu and Miki Igarashi. . .

A strained hamstring caused North Carolina's frosh prize, Monique Hennagan, to miss three weeks of training prior to the NCAAs. The Tar Heels scratched their 4 x 4 to allow Hennagan to concentrate on the 400 with a minimum of stress, but she failed to make the final. . .

LaVonna Martin-Floréal, the Barcelona Olympics 100H silver medalist, is expecting her first child this year and plans to return to competition in 1996 at the latest.

Martin-Floréal's husband, Canadian triple jumper Edrick Floréal, suffered an apparently gruesome ligament tear in his right knee at the World Indoor and had to be carried out on a stretcher. Nonetheless, he hopes to be back for the summer season.
