U.S. Bid For '97 Worlds

It may have been reported in your local paper on April 1, but rest assured, it's no April Fool's joke. A bid is being formulated which would put the currently-without-at-home 1997 World Championships in Stanford Stadium.

The plan was conceived by a pair of San José attorneys, Tom Bartasi and Nick Petredis, working in conjunction with Jenner meet director Bert Bonanno. The group has been consulting with Rich Perelman, who served as vice president of press operations at the '84 Olympics and now runs his own international event-management group.

"I think it's a very workable concept," says Perelman, who explains that at this stage, the protocol is for USATF to make a formal application with the IAAF (which it has), and then to forward application papers to the Bay Area group.

The IAAF is then expected to consider all bids at its May Council meeting in Göteborg. It is known that the IAAF is not happy with the thought of so many Worlds being in Europe, so the existence of no other outside-Europe bids could be a strong point in the U.S.'s favor.

Stanford fits most of the requirements one would demand of a WC site: it's in a significant population area served by a major international airport, has plenty of suitable housing nearby (for athletes, press and fans), would have fabulous weather, has a grass infield and has a large seating capacity (currently c85,000).

Anyone who has seen the facility, however, will be quick to ask, "What about the track?" Indeed, the current layout is an archaic yard track, with only 7 narrow lanes, butting up against the stands at the ends.

Perelman says preliminary engineering reports indicate that a modern wide-radius track could be installed with only minimal (and acceptable) disruption of the seating pattern. "Stanford has been very supportive," notes Perelman. USATF's involvement to this point has simply been to act as the requisite conduit to the IAAF.

TV Series Loses Money

Dick Patrick of *USA Today* says that USATF's indoor TV series will cost the federation at least \$300,000. Final revenue figures aren't in yet.

USATF head Ollan Cassell said the losses are less than expected and "a necessary investment to promote a sport with a shrinking profile."

Alvin Chriss of IMG, a partner with USATF in the new venture, said, "We did something good. We did it in opposition to a million people. You know how many people hate me because they think I put Ollan up to the federation losing money?"

Super 10K On Tap

By the time you read this, the Dogwood Relays may have already produced a terrific men's 10K.

Coach Doug Brown says Todd Williams, fresh off a great performance at the World Cross Country, is in PR shape, which means sub-27:40.

He won't have to go it alone, as a trio of tough Kenyans will also be in the race. One is Joseph Kimani, a runner Kenya dropped from its XC team at the last moment. He then flew to Mobile, Alabama, for the Azalea Trail race and equaled Arturo Barrios's loop 10K WR of 27:41.

Kimani got to Mobile the night before, never saw the course and, according to *Running Stats*, didn't run anywhere near the tangents.

Also in the field are 27:24.24 performer Ondoro Osoro and Simon Chemoiywo, the

runner-up in the '94 World XC.

"They could run the fastest 10K in the U.S. in years," says Brown. The U.S. soil record is 27:26.43 set by Hammou Boutayeb of Morocco at the '90 Goodwill Games in Seattle.
