Big U.S. Meets Deathly Ill

A year ago at this time, the U.S. looked to be in its best position ever, with two Grand Prix I meets and one GP II meet on tap.

But as we go to press in the middle of April, the situation looks particularly bleak. And it all boils down to one thing—sponsorship (or rather, a lack thereof).

The downturn started last year when the GP II meet, Indianapolis, was canceled because of title-sponsor problems. Assurances were given that the meet would come off this year. It won't.

Says Paula Snow of IMG, "We just didn't have enough sponsors to get it to work. We'd like to have an indoor meet, and we'd like to have it in Indy. This year we sort of concentrated on indoor track. We hope to concentrate on outdoors in the near future."

Not dead, but gasping for its last breath, is the meet that had the honor of being the first IAAF/Mobil GP meet ever held, the Jenner Classic.

As we write, the meet had two days left in which to find a sponsor willing to come up with \$150,000, or it too would go the way of the dodo.

"We've sent feelers out to every major Olympic sponsor, including Silicon Valley computer companies," says meet director Bert Bonanno.

Bonanno says that Mobil and Nike came close to making deals but backed out when Bonanno couldn't deliver a TV package. USATF, still concerned about absorbing losses incurred with the indoor TV series (see p. 74), was apparently unable to provide succor in that department.

The only good news at the moment is that the New York Games, also rumored to be on the way out (again) has come up with an as-yet-unnamed sponsor, so that fixture will stay alive one more year.

All this is most chilling, when one considers that next year we've got the Olympics in the United States, and corporate types are said to be salivating at the thought of being able to connect themselves with the whole affair.

Coe On Aouita Comeback

Former mile WR holder Seb Coe wishes Said Aouita well in his comeback at age 35 but told Pat Butcher in *Athletics Weekly* that he's skeptical.

"The psychology of retirement is interesting," said Coe. "When you get past 30, dis-

tance lends enchantment—you forget how hard it was. You've really got to be brutal with yourself.

"He rescripted the way the 5000m is run, and if that's what he's coming back to, it's a long way to hurt. If you hurt at 600m in an 800m you know it's only just over 20 seconds to go. But if you hurt in the middle of a 5000, it's six laps to go."

Coe, now a member of the British parliament concluded, "Comebacks, like political careers, very rarely end happily."
