## Sprint Schedule Flap

Hot weather is the norm in Sacramento in mid-June, but the proposed time schedule for the USATF Championships is creating plenty of its own springtime heat.

Objections are being raised about the 200 finals being staged before the 100s. Critics point out that the last time a similar schedule was followed—in '87—there were negative ramifications.

Carl Lewis won the 200, with Wallace Spearmon 2nd, Calvin Smith 3rd, Thomas Jefferson 5th and Henry Thomas 7th.

The next day, Lewis ran 2nd in the 100 to unexpected winner Mark Witherspoon, Smith placed 5th, Jefferson ran only 6th in his semi, and Spearmon and Thomas didn't compete in the semis at all.

The women's outcome was similar. Pam Marshall won the 200 over Florence Griffith, Grace Jackson, Juliet Cuthbert, Evelyn Ashford, Pauline Davis and Gwen Torrence.

Then, in the 100, Marshall placed 3rd, while Ashford and Jackson ran 6th and 7th in their semi. Cuthbert didn't finish her semi and Davis didn't even run.

One of the most vociferous critics of the proposed schedule is the Santa Monica TC's Joe Douglas, who recalls the '87 effects well.

"Even though he won the 100, Mark Witherspoon was nicked up," Douglas points out. "Carl was injured and so were several others. An event as explosive as the 100 shouldn't follow anything. It should be first.

"I feel the Sacramento organizers have made a serious error. The decision is either naïve or malicious and I hope it's rectified."

Some critics, Douglas *not* among them, have labeled it a "Michael Johnson schedule," since the sprint great has openly said he wants to make the World Champs team in both the 200 and 400, since that double is feasible in Göteborg.

Johnson's agent, Brad Hunt responds, "It's obvious that is a belief generated by paranoia. My understanding is that television [ABC], in its negotiations with USATF, requested that the 100 and 400 finals for both men and women be on the meet's final day.

"Anyone who knows Michael knows he much prefers to run the 400 *first*. He wants to get that out of the way and not have to save anything for a hard 400 late in a meet."

This winter, Johnson said, "I feel it's a doable schedule. Otherwise I wouldn't try it.

All I want is to have one event over before I have to do the next one."

In Göteborg, the 400 final is set for August 9, with the 200 heats beginning the next morning. But in Sacramento, Johnson will have little break if the suggested schedule is used: the 400 heats follow the 200 final by about two hours. "That overlap definitely isn't Michael's preference," Hunt adds.

Douglas also is disturbed by the last day's lineup, which stages the men's long jump during the same timeframe as the 100 final.

"If I were complaining just for my own athletes, I would complain loudest for that conflict because it handicaps Carl," Douglas says. "But my bigger complaint is more people getting injured in the sprints. The schedule could hurt everyone, and that's the sad thing about it."

Douglas has spoken with a wide range of movers in the sport, from coaches Bob Kersee, John Smith, Tom Tellez and Brooks Johnson, to administrators Dean Hayes and Lynn Cannon, and even meet official Al Baeta. He claims all agreed the 100 should be staged before the 200.

Hunt adds, "I understand that enough noise about changing the schedule is being made by a lot of people that USATF and television are talking."

Douglas says, "It's imperative that the schedule be changed. It's serious enough a situation that we won't put our best team forward if that schedule is run. I just hope that wisdom will prevail and that the schedule is changed for the better."

## L'Équipe Likes Stanford

If the French sports daily *L'Équipe* is right, we will enjoy the 1997 edition of the World Champs in the U.S.

In an April 17 *Los Angeles Times* story, Olympic & track writer Randy Harvey says the Paris-based *L'Équipe* likes best the chances of Stanford to host the '97 meet.

Stanford is the U.S. bidder among the seven sites which stepped into the breach left with Mexico City's withdrawal.

Harvey wrote, "According to *L'Équipe*, [candidates] Rome and Helsinki are longshots because they have played host to the [meet] before. Athens is also doubtful because it [will] stage the World Indoor that year. Split, Croatia, has obvious problems..."

"That leaves Stanford, New Delhi and a Spanish city to be determined."

Harvey adds that the French paper feels Stanford has the edge because the IAAF would like to see major events in the U.S. two years in a row—the '96 Atlanta Olympics, then the '97 Worlds—to boost American interest in track.

Members of the San José-based Partnership 1997, which is seeking the Worlds, are to meet in Philadelphia over the April 28-29 weekend with USATF's Executive Committee.

He adds, "I hate to keep telling people, 'Tomorrow, tomorrow.' But so many different balls keep getting thrown into the air, that's all anyone can say."

## Mobil Out of Track?

Sponsorship woes continue for track. An April 25 story in the *Chicago Tribune* claims Mobil Corp., track's most beneficent corporate patron for the past 15 years, may end its association with the sport after 1996.

The article, written by Phil Hersh, reports that Mobil will end its annual funding—claimed to be more than \$11 million—of the indoor and outdoor Grand Prix circuits, sponsorship of the U.S. indoor and outdoor title meets and the Fairfax indoor meet.

As well, the oil giant reportedly will not continue to sponsor the winter series of U.S. televised meets. That price tag was believed to be \$1.25 million.

Hersh's story claims Mobil's decision to end its track sponsorship—which dates back to 1981—“owes to both disenchantment with track's leadership, particularly in the U.S., and [Mobil's] resistance to demands for more sponsorship money” by the IAAF.

Hersh claims the IAAF's world marketer ISL has asked Mobil to increase its \$6 million annual backing of the outdoor GP to \$7 million for each of the next four years.

Representatives of ISL and Mobil are said to be having continuing discussions on the issue.

As for the television series, the *Tribune* story claimed that on April 20, Mobil told both USATF and IMG, its partner in producing the series, that it would not renew its sponsorship.

An IMG representative denied a decision has been made, claiming discussions were continuing.

And a Mobil spokesman claimed everything regarding the company and track is “under review.”
