Sacto 100 Reunion

It's a safe bet the men's 100 final will be fast at June's USATF meet. But the whole competition will have to go a long way to match the electrifying centuries produced at the '68 AAU meet, also held in Sacramento's Hughes Stadium.

The '68 dashes produced the greatest one-day collection of sprint performances anyone had ever seen. With the World Record a hand-timed 10.0, the AAU races resulted in two WR ties of 10-flat in the heats, a pair of 9.9 WRs in the first semi and another 9.9 in the second. There was also a wind-aided 9.8 and a total of 32 times at 10.1 or faster.

At this year's national championships, Accusplit and Nike will bring together some of the stars of that fabulous night.

Invitees include the trio of 9.9 sprinters—Jim Hines, Charlie Greene and Ronnie Ray Smith—as well as standouts Lennox Miller, Mel Pender, Billy Gaines, Larry Questad and Roger Bambuck.

The sprinters will be introduced at the meet on Saturday, June 17, in a ceremony which will include them walking the 100m straight in their '68 lanes.

Prep Coaches To Meet

High school track coaches will hold their first national convention and clinic this summer in Indianapolis. The gathering, sponsored by the High School Track & Cross Country Coaches of America, is set for July 20-22.

Featured clinic speakers will include noted prep coaches Joe Newton, John Hemmer, Ken Brauman, Jim Holdren and Rita Somerlot—all staff members on recent Olympic or national teams. Sue Humphrey, chair of USATF's Women's Development Committee, also will speak.

"Our group is an offshoot of the U.S. Track Coaches Association," says clinic organizer Criss Somerlot of Centerville, Ohio. "And our convention and clinic fits in with USATF's goals involving high school development." Somerlot notes that the National High School Federation also backs the convention/clinic.

"In 1996, we hope to hold our convention and clinic at the Olympic Trials," Somerlot

says. "That's the logical place for coaches to get together."

The '95 clinic will cost \$50 before July 17, and college credit also may be earned for attendance. For further information, call Somerlot (513/439-4927), Hemmer (407/859-3035) or registrar Mike Holman (317/843-9436).
