ATHENS GETS '97 BID

IAAF Takes Major Steps

GÖTEBORG, SWEDEN, May 21-23—The year's second IAAF Council meeting figured to be important because a successor to Mexico City as host of the '97 Worlds was to be chosen, but the selection of Athens as the new site was only one of many major decisions at a monumental gathering.

Madrid went into the meeting as the favorite to capture the '97 WC, but ended up joining Stanford, Helsinki and New Delhi as also-rans. Some analysts feel the decision to award the meet to Athens was a "sympathy vote" following the Greeks' surprise loss of the centennial Olympics to Atlanta.

"There's no doubt that Athens feels a bit redeemed by this outcome," said IAAF press chief Christopher Winner. "Their hopes were high for the '96 Olympics, so the IAAF is pleased to give the opportunity to stage the World Championships."

The American bid was apparently hampered by the need for funds to refurbish the Stanford Stadium, whereas the Greek bid came free of any requests for financial aid.

The Athens win may be a shot in the heart to Seville and any other European cities hoping to bid for the '99 meet, as the IAAF would seem unlikely to award the meet to three European cities in a row. That bodes well for another American try, although one has to suspect that virgin IAAF territory like New Delhi or Johannesburg would be looked on very kindly.

Athens was also on line to host the '97 World Indoor, but in light of this success has relinquished that honor. The IAAF will announce a new bidding procedure soon. Paris is being touted as the favored replacement site.

Women On IAAF Council

Finally recognizing the need to number women among its members, the IAAF Council will expand from 25 to 27, assuming the IAAF Congress as a whole (which meets at the Worlds) supports the idea by a two-thirds majority.

The move has been termed a "onetime transitional clause," as the guarantee of seats for women is limited to a special 2-spot election before the rest of the Council is voted upon at the Congress. Women will be eligible for the other 25 positions as well, however.

Said IAAF president Primo Nebiolo, "After

the election of the new Council the rule will vanish because it will have served its purpose, which is to end any form of sexual discrimination."

Four women have already been nominated for election, with more expected.

Drug Penalties To Lessen?

The Congress must also approve a recommendation to change the first-time ban for steroid-class drugs to "a minimum of 2 years."

IAAF medical chair Dr. Arne Ljungqvist said this move is in support of the IOC's desire to standardize drug bans. "This still leaves federations open to applying a stricter ban if needed or wished for," explained Ljungqvist. "But it is in the interest of the whole sporting world that drug policies are made uniform."

Ngugi Reinstated

Citing the "exceptional circumstances rule," the Council reinstated Kenyan cross country star John Ngugi. Ngugi was banned for 4 years in February of '93 for refusing a drug test. The ban was upheld by an IAAF Arbitration Panel, and the medical commission also recommended that the ban stand.

The Council, however, cited language problems and a lack of communication to athletes by the Kenyan federation and said that Ngugi had "suffered enough."

A bid by Russian hurdler Lyudmila Narozhilenko to have her 4-year steroid penalty truncated to 2 years was denied.

Also denied was a bid by Italian hurdler Giannina Re (see box) to have her steroid penalty lifted.

Improved Field Event Structure

Following a recommendation from the Technical Committee, the IAAF will this year experiment with the NCAA's method of ordering in the field events: i.e., after the first three jumps/throws, the finalists will be put in inverse order of performance, ensuring that the leaders finish each round. The "new" method is to be used in all this year's GP meets.

The Council is also concerned about the amount of time that field events take and is looking at ways to streamline them. It is rumored that a cut from six rounds to four might even be considered. There are studies that have shown

that relatively few significant marks are made by having the two extra trials (particularly if you eliminate rounds 4 and 5, as 6 typically produces comethrough performances).

Speeding Up The Sport

Continuing on the theme of making the sport more presentable, Nebiolo said, "Sometimes we behave as if it were 1950, not 1995. We must work at giving the public a show. We must keep spectators. We must highlight the athletes and not make people watch as officials—including myself—award medals."

Other Actions

- Former Kenyans Wilson Kipketer and Robert Kiplagat were both made eligible to represent Denmark. Kipketer was ranked No. 1 in the world in the 800 last year.

- The IAAF will appeal a German court decision that has cleared Katrin Krabbe of the IAAF's charge of "bringing the sport into disrepute."

- Northern Ireland (city to be named) will host the '99 World Cross Country.

- An Athletes Commission recommendation that the top 3 at the World Championships receive prize money was accepted (no time frame was given, however). ■

NCAA Ignores Bans

The NCAA has never recognized drug penalties imposed by other bodies. Thus it is that Italian hurdler Giannina Re, banned for 4 years by the IAAF, is competing for Arizona State. She says she no longer has an interest in running internationally, and just wants to fund her education.

"From our point of view, Re is flagrantly abusing our regulations," said the IAAF's Christopher Winner, who noted that anybody who competes against her theoretically could also face a ban.

"It is not entirely her fault, because the NCAA does not fall under USATF jurisdiction," he continued. "However, we would expect athletes who have openly admitted taking illegal drugs to set an example by accepting their penalties, serving their time and then returning to athletics."

"Re knows she's banned, but she's running just to help herself through college. That's the equivalent of burning down the tree in order to get the cat."
