Prize Money In Athens

IAAF president Primo Nebiolo says that athletes will have a pool of more than \$7 million offered as prize money for the 1997 World Championships in Athens.

"Göteborg received a grant of \$7.5 million from us to organize these championships," Nebiolo told *La Gazzetta dello Sport* at the close of the IAAF Council meeting in Sweden. "Athens won't get a cent. This money will go to those who create the spectacle—the athletes."

The decision to use the grant money for the athletes rather than meet organizers indicates the direction the IAAF will take in future bids. More important than any political or geographical considerations will be the bottom line. Cities which need IAAF help to stage meets need not apply; those that can pay their own way should.

The people behind Stanford's failed bid for the '97 Worlds say they are eager to forge ahead with a new proposal for the '99 meet.

Paris is apparently very interested in the '99 affair, although the IAAF reportedly has some concerns about soccer's World Cup, which will be in the French capital in '98 and could overshadow efforts to promote the track meet ahead of time.

Paris and Osaka have been cited by Nebiolo as candidates to stage the '97 World Indoor, which Athens relinquished upon earning the right to replace Mexico City for the outdoor version.

Judge Says No To Gravelle

Bruce Jenner Classic organizers heaved a sigh of relief the day before the meet when a Superior Court judge rejected discus thrower Mike Gravelle's plea to compete in the meet.

Gravelle is under an IAAF and USATF suspension after testing positive for testosterone. Judge Stuart Pollack refused to reinstate Gravelle saying that missing the meet would not cause Gravelle undue hardship. Had he ruled that Gravelle be allowed to participate at Jenner, athletes who competed in the meet would have risked falling afoul of the IAAF's "contamination" rule. Fortunately, it didn't come to that.

Gravelle's lawyer, George C. Harris, said he thought the judge viewed the nationals differently. "We would expect to be in a strong position to ask for the court's assis-

tance if we haven't received the opportunity for a fair hearing," he said. USATF is apparently going to give Gravelle a hearing on June 4.

Kenyan Unrest Continues

Talk of Kenyan athletes boycotting the World Championships has distressed the African Amateur Athletic Confederation. "Much as we look at it as mere agitation by disgruntled athletes who want to have things go their way, we can never forget that we are athletes' servants. We work for them," said AAAC vice president Sam Nelson of Ghana.

John Ngugi was quick to lambaste the Kenyan federation after the IAAF lifted his ban, saying the national governing body had failed to support him. "Some of them were too jealous," he charged. "They wanted kickbacks from athletes. Some wonder why we own big cars. Some officials were happy about my predicament; only my fellow athletes fought for me."

Ngugi said he has put on some 50lb in the last couple of years but nonetheless expects to be back at his running weight in 3-4 months. He has targeted the Atlanta 5000 as his main goal.

Names In The News

Maybe no long jumping for Carl Lewis at the Worlds? "I still don't know whether I'll be running the 200 or doing the long jump," he said at the New York Games. "The [Sacramento] schedule doesn't allow me to double. I'll decide on the week of the competition." . . .

No more "Green Machine" for Dennis Mitchell. No, now he's the *Mean Green Machine*. "I'm going to have a meaner approach this year, to maintain my No. 1 ranking." With the new name comes a minor uniform change: "This year'll it'll be a basic green outfit with royal blue stripes." . . .

Ron Roddan, coach of Linford Christie, says, "Linford likes a challenge, and if anyone can make him rise, it's the Americans. They always seem to say the right thing, and he loves rubbing their noses in it." . . .

Gwen Torrence says her training has

been going very well: "I sometimes run alongside Kevin Young. He goes over hurdles and I try to beat him on the flat; he has to watch out!" . . .

The entry list for the Pre Classic continues to burgeon, and now contains no fewer than 16 athletes who own OG or WC gold medals. Ticket sales are on pace to create the first true sellout of Hayward Field since the '76 Olympic Trials. . .

China appears to have another miracle-working coach in the person of Feng Shuyong. Feng works his magic in the men's long jump, where his athletes took the first four places at the Chinese Championships. Huang Geng (25) won with an Asian Record 27-6 (8.38), followed by Xu Ping (25), Wen Yutao (21) and Huang Baoting (21), who jumped 26-7³/₄ (8.12), 26-5¹/₂ (8.06) and 26-4¹/₄ (8.03). . .

Montréal Olympic hurdle champ Guy Drut has been named the minister of youth & sports in France's new government. . .

The NCAA has added the women's hammer to the Div. I and II championships, effective next year. Div. III already contests the event.

At the indoor nationals for all three NCAA divisions, the women's 20lb weight will be included. . .

Rome's GP meet has changed dates, from June 7 to June 8. . .

Last year's No. 3-ranked decathlete, Alain Blondel, won't compete before Göteborg, being troubled by a pull in his right thigh. . .

Bryan Bronson has left Rice and will not compete at the NCAA. . .
