Kiptanui Wants More

Moses Kiptanui was thrilled to become a double WR holder, adding the 5K standard to the steeple mark he already claimed. Now he has other lofty goals.

"I'd love to become the first to run the steeplechase in under 8:00, and the first under 12:50 in the 5000. My Rome time [12:55.30] won't last; it will be beaten soon. There are so many talented runners today."

Kiptanui also wants to try a steeple/5K double at the World Championships. It's not the easiest of doubles, but if anybody could pull it off, it would be Kiptanui. To do it he'd run steeple heats on Monday and semis on Wednesday. On Thursday he'd have the 5000 heats. Friday would be the tough day, with the steeple final at 5:30 and the 5000 semis at 7:55. The 5000 final is Sunday.

Kiptanui has a tougher foe than the Swedish schedule though. It's the Kenyan one. "The two finals are on the same day in Nairobi," he explains, noting the fierce competition he'll have at the Kenyan Nationals (at some 5500ft of altitude).

"Maybe I'll try to double with the 1500 instead," he muses. In Göteborg the 1500 heats are Thursday, semis Friday and final Sunday.

The Luck Of The Draw

Santa Monica TC head Joe Douglas called it "one of the greatest hatchet jobs I've ever seen," but the unfortunate placement of Michael Marsh in lane 1 of the 200 final at the nationals—and his subsequent 6th-place finish after winning the 100—was done strictly by the rules.

The ranking protocol (where 3 semis are involved): fastest semi winner, second-fastest semi winner, third-fastest semi winner, fastest semi 2nd-placer, second-fastest semi 2nd-placer, etc., etc. Time qualifiers (if any), are ranked at the bottom.

The top four rankers are put in a random draw for lanes 3-6, and the other four in a random draw for 1-2 and 7-8. Since Marsh was No. 5-ranked (being second-fastest of the three semi runners-up), he was in the lesser draw and got 1.

What really screwed Marsh were the wind and the cut-down process. Marsh only had a legal 1.0 wind aid, and he ran 20.19. Meanwhile a 2.3 breeze in the third semi helped Jon Drummond to a 20.10. Intrinsicly, Marsh's was the far-superior run.

One also suspects that Marsh would have ended up in the better half if the draw if only two semis had been run, but officials didn't want to drop the field from 41 all the way to 16, so instead chose to go the 24-runner route with three semis.

It is interesting to note, however, that the 100 worked just fine on a 39-16-8 system.

Samaranch Gets Reprive

The big news out of a mid-June meeting of the International Olympic Committee was supposed to be the awarding of the 2002 Winter Olympics (which went to Salt Lake City), but also making big headlines were the machinations surrounding age limits for its members.

The group first failed to ratify a plan which would have allowed IOC president Juan Antonio Samaranch to stay on after his enforced retirement at age 75 in 1997. Canada's Dick Pound, widely seen as the Spaniard's most likely successor, called it "a wonderful afternoon of democracy in action."

But just three days later, in a move orchestrated by the IOC's Latin block, the age limit for all members was raised to 80 in a show-of-hands ballot after a secret ballot move was voted down.

Reuters writer Paul Radford said some felt the decision "smacks of giving jobs for life to passengers on the IOC gravy train."

Among the architects of the new plan was IAAF head Primo Nebiolo, 71. Nebiolo disclaimed any personal stake in the decision, saying, "It's going to give five more years to all members, not just me. What is five more years on the IOC? I have plenty of other things to do."

Names In The News

After his 10K WR, Haile Gebrselassie said, "I'll rest now. If somebody steals one of my records, then I'll just have to return to the track and take it back."

It only took 70-odd hours before Moses Kiptanui claimed the Ethiopian's 5K standard. His big push to reclaim the mark will come at the Paris meet on July 3, with Morocco's Khalid Skah as legitimate competition...
