## The Great Hurdle Snafu

In a meet where contingencies of nearly every imaginable sort varied the format of semifinal rounds, the men's 110H in Sacramento got a truly odd configuration—three semis with 5, 6 and 7 hurdlers—through the most convoluted snafu of the meet.

It all started in the heats when Allen Johnson (lane 7) hit a hurdle, the base of which wheeled into Michigan football star Tyrone Wheatley's trail-leg thigh. Wheatley in (lane 8) spun 90 degrees to the right, bounced off sponsor signage in lane 9 and missed the next hurdle before stopping.

An official advised Wheatley to protest and Johnson drew a disqualification. Wheatley was advanced to the semis even though he failed to finish.

Johnson said, "I knew the disqualification wasn't right. I was not going to let them start the race without me. Even if I had to knock over hurdles on the track, I was not going to be left out."

It didn't come to that, as manager Tony Campbell lodged a successful appeal on the grounds that Johnson's hurdling was by the book, and that he had nothing to do with Wheatley's problem. By then, however, two semis of 8 runners had been seeded and the scheduled race time had arrived.

With lane 9 unusable due to the corporate signage, three heats to accommodate 17 runners were drawn by an official working feverishly with the track as his writing desk.

Semi 1 got 5 runners and the other two 6 each. As the first-race hurdlers settled into their blocks, Texas A&M's Larry Wade, who had originally been listed as making the semis based on Johnson's DQ, argued he should not be denied a spot. With the meet now 20 minutes behind schedule, the officials placed him in semi 3 rather than argue.

Ironically, pro football draftee Wheatley didn't care that much about making the semis. When told of Johnson's DQ, he said, "I was going to say, 'Just forget it. This is the guy's livelihood; he can have it. Don't disqualify him.'"

Wheatley's sentiments, however, never reached meet officials until long afterwards.

## Names In The News

Britain had some significant absences at the Euro Cup: Colin Jackson had tonsillitis, Yvonne Murray had a bad knee and Rob Denmark didn't want to negatively impact his World Champs preparations. . .

USATF has created a new position, Manager Of Promotions. Filling the spot will be Paula Snow, late of IMG. . .

Ron Reid of the *Philadelphia Inquirer* on how the lane draw might have affected the Michael Johnson/Michael Marsh 200 battle in Sacramento: "One suspects it would have turned out that way had Johnson run in lane 1. Carrying a briefcase and an umbrella. . ."

Noting that baseball is taking steps to speed itself up, Steve Hummer of the *Atlanta Journal-Constitution* came up with a list of suggestions for other sports to do the same. His take on running: "Ten miles should

qualify as a marathon—anything more is a senseless repetition for the benefit of various Kenyans. . ."

According to *Athletics Weekly*, a potential candidate to run against Primo Nebiolo for the IAAF's presidency this summer has been boxed out. Council member Eisa Al Dashti of Kuwait, was apparently set to challenge Nebiolo's 14-year reign, but Nebiolo flew to Kuwait and talked with Kuwaiti muckeymucks who then announced that Al Dashti's candidacy would be withdrawn.

Nebiolo may have a more immediate problem. In late-June a prosecutor asked a court on to sentence Nebiolo to jail on charges linked to construction work for the '90 World Cup soccer finals. The prosecutor made his request at the trial of 16 Italian sports officials charged with abuse of power over the immense costs of converting Rome's Olympic Stadium to host Cup games. All the defendants claim innocence. . .

Bruny Surin tells correspondent Paul Gains he feels the Canadian 4x1 team can run a WR time this year. Surin, Glenroy Gilbert and Donovan Bailey especially are all running quite well at moment. Plus, they all believe they can upset anybody at WC. . .

Chryste Gaines PRed in the Sacramento semis at 11.02, but ran only 11.45 for 5th in the final. A calf muscle cramped a few steps out of the blocks; that hobbled her for the whole race. . .

With Doug Brown moving to Gainesville to take over the head job at Florida, it's not known yet whether Todd Williams will move from Knoxville also. "We know we're going to continue the coaching relationship," says Brown.

"Gainesville is a possibility, staying in Knoxville and working with me long distance is a possibility, and so is moving to Bloomington so he could train with Bob Kennedy. We'll see. . ."

With stress fractures in the arches of both feet, **Natasha Kaiser-Brown**, will be missing the entire outdoor season. "I finally got the clearance to run in time for outdoors, and I got in about a week of training and it felt like it broke again," says the Stuttgart runnerup at 400.
