Johnson Not Satisfied

Dash star Michael Johnson has rejected out of hand the IAAF's plan to ease his road toward an Olympic 200/400 double by lengthening the time gap between the 200 semis and 400 final (*T&FN*, August).

IAAF head Primo Nebiolo said, "If he wants to run backwards he could still do it. The schedule is very good for him. I wrote to him, 'Be tranquil.' He could be the hero of the track & field in Atlanta."

Johnson's cold response was, "This is not what I'm looking for. I would have to finish all four rounds of the 400 before I started the 200. If that isn't done, I can't do it."

While we're all for a modification that would allow Johnson to double, his request for a complete separation simply isn't feasible. At least not as long as four rounds of each race are required (that's another matter that requires a hard look: why allow so many sprinters into the meet?).

Splitting the events completely would remove the rest day that each currently enjoys (the 200 between the heats/quarters day and the semis; the 400 between the semis and final). Other runners, who might be jealous enough just at the modification for Johnson's sake would go ballistic at that.

Even worse, it would put the 200 semis on the same day as the heats of both relays and the 200 final on the same day as both relay finals. That wouldn't negatively impact the U.S., but could wreak havoc with smaller nations who are forced to double their sprinters in more events.

Johnson can (and should) get a better deal than what the IAAF has offered so far (as he says, "Whatever race I don't run will be a joke"), but his complete-separation request is out of the question.

Dueling Altitude Sites

Should it be Colorado Springs (altitude 2153m) or Sestriere (altitude 2050m)? Long jump WR holder Mike Powell broke 29 at the Italian site in both '92 and '94. On the former occasion he produced the longest jump ever, a wind-aided 29-6.

But this year he says he is interested in jumping at the Olympic Festival the same weekend.

"Mike is very serious about attempting to break the World Record," says agent Brad

Hunt. One potential hangup: the Powell camp is looking for "financial arrangements."

Imagine the irony of Powell coming to Colorado to jump, and not breaking the WR, while at the same time hot Ivan Pedroso goes to Italy and does break it.

The Cuban, with his back-to-back GP wins over Powell at Paris and Lausanne, gave Powell his first consecutive losses since July of 1990. That was when he lost at Barcelona (to Carl Lewis and Robert Emmiyan) and the Goodwill Games (to Lewis).

Nebiolo Exonerated

Nebiolo got good news in early July when he (and all 15 other defendants) were cleared of all charges of "abuse of power" relating to the immense costs of converting Rome's Olympic Stadium to host the '90 World Cup soccer finals (*TN*, July 5).

The court ruled that there was "no offense committed." Nebiolo was listed as one of the defendants because he was a member of the Italian Olympic Committee's executive board. . .

Conley's Late-Round Habit

"It seems like I'm always winning on my last one," said Mike Conley in Sacramento after yet another come-from-behind win. "I don't plan it that way, but it gives me a shot of adrenaline. On the sixth jump, no matter how unmotivated I am, I get that shot of adrenaline. I can handle it because of the experience I have."

His major-meet last-round comethroughs:

•1983 NCAA Indoor TJ: in 2nd, jumped 56-6³/₄ to beat Keith Connor (55-8¹/₄).

•1985 U.S. Indoor LJ: in 2nd, jumped 26-11³/₄ to win over Larry Myricks (26-7¹/₄).

•1986 U.S. Indoor LJ: Myricks (26-11) took lead from Conley (26-7¹/₄) in the last round. Conley responded with a 27-1³/₄ to win.

•1987 U.S. Indoor TJ: in 2nd, jumped WR 58-3³/₄ to defeat WR holder Oleg Protzenko (57-7¹/₄).

•1987 World Indoor TJ: in 2nd, jumped 57-6¹/₂ to beat Protzenko (56-7¹/₂) again.

•1988 U.S. TJ: in 2nd, jumped 56-11³/₄ to defeat Willie Banks (56-3³/₄).

•1989 U.S. Indoor TJ: in 2nd, jumped

56-10 to better the 56-6³/₄ by Charlie Simpkins.

•1995 WC Trials TJ: in 2nd, jumped 56-4¹/₂ to pass Ivory Angello (56-1¹/₂w).

But that's not all! In 5 other meets of this caliber he got his best jump of the day and improved his place, although not to first. And in 6 more he was already in the lead but improved anyway (including his best mark ever, 59-7¹/₂w, to win the '92 Olympics).

And in 3 other majors ('85 U.S. LJ, '87 WC Trials TJ, '94 U.S. TJ) Conley took the lead in the fifth round on his way to a win.

Lesson: never leave the arena early if Conley has a jump remaining.

Names In The News

Decathletes crashed and burned in the vault box at Sacramento when high winds and rain became more than a minor problem.

Eric Long, for one, was carried out of the stadium on a stretcher after a warmup mishap. But after x-rays showed no fracture ("just" a separated shoulder), he returned and eventually cleared 15-5 some three hours later.

Steve Fritz didn't have a crash landing, but he strained his left quad trying to jump into a "25mph" wind and had to call it a day after clearing just 14-1¹/₄ (he did 16-2³/₄ in his PR score).

Before the vault began he was in 4th, and while well behind PR pace, was some 75 points up on the marks that gave him an 8343 at Talence last year. Even an average finish would have brought him in well ahead of the 8257 it took to make the team. . .

Out with a drug ban for some three years, German sprinter Grit Breuer plans a big-time return at the ISTAF meet in September. . .

Latest update on Marc Davis: he has had surgery on a nerve in his foot, but hopes to be back for the post-Göteborg part of the European season. . .

After missing most of the U.S. season with injury, 800 AR holder Johnny Gray is expected to compete in Europe this summer. "He said he feels good and wants to race," reports manager Joe Douglas. . .

Sprinter Holli Hyché, troubled by knee pain all year, missed the USATF meet when she had knee surgery that weekend. . .
