Record to look for in Tokyo:

- 2) Can Cheptegei or Kiplimo win first medal for UGA at this event?
- 3) Can Barega or Kejelcha become first World Youth Champion to win the Olympic gold?
- 4) If Cheptegei, Kwemoi or Kipruto win, he will be the second (after Haile) World Junior Champion to win the Olympics.
