

2020 Olympic Games Statistics – Men's TJ

The records to look for in Tokyo:

- 1) If Will Claye wins third medal, he will tie Vilho Tuulos (FIN), just behind Saneyev with four.
- 2) Can Zango Hugues win first medal, perhaps even gold, for BUR? If he medal, he will be the first African Games and African Championships gold medalist to win an Olympic medal.
- 3) If Pichardo wins, he will be the first World Junior Champion to win Olympic gold.
