The records to look for in Eugene:

- 1) Can Taylor win record tying fifth medal?
- 2) Can Hugues Fabrice Zango win first gold (or even first silver) for BUR? If he wins gold, Zango will be the first TJ to win both African Games and WC.
- 3) Pichardo, if he wins gold, will be 8th to win both WC and OG, 3rd to win both WC and World Junior.
